Form 990, Part III, Line 4d: THRIFT STORE AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING (The organization operated two thrift store in Lexington (720 Bryan Ave. and 487 E. New Circle Road). Most of the revenue from the stores are from the sale of used merchandise donated to the organization. (The New Circle Road store was closed on October 31, 2011 due to declining sales). The stores are operated by employees of the mission. Supervised trainees and volunteers supplement the work. Trainees from the residential programs, Urban League, Community Action of Northern Kentucky, Dismass Charities, and Food Stamp office are assigned supervised work at the stores and some are assigned to help the truck driver pick-up larger donated items. Clothing vouchers issued through the Outreach Services Division of the organization are fulfilled at the stores. Form 990, Part VI, Line 11b: The officers and directors will be sent an electronic copy of the Form 990 a few days in advance of the filling deadline date with instructions to review the form and direct questions and comments to the Executive Director prior to submission. Form 990, Part VI, Line 12c: Officers, directors, and key employees annually complete a questionnaire that is reviewed by the board to determine the extent, if any, of any real, perceived, or potential conflicts of interest. The board will periodically review and update its Conflict of Interest Policy. Form 990, Part VI, Line 15a: The Executive Director's compensation is approved by the organization's board each year. Comparable compensation data is reviewed by the Board's Compensation Committee, and the Committee presents its findings and recommendations to the full-board for its approval, which is documented in the Board Minutes. Form 990, Part VI, Line 19: The organization makes copies of its articles of incorporation, bylaws, conflict of interest policy, and financial statements available upon request. In addition, the most current copy of audited financial statements, Form 990, and Annual Report are posted on the organization's web site. There are also links on the web site to GoodGiving.net, Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability (ECFA), GuideStar, and the Better Business Bureau, which all have profiles of the organization. Form, Part III, Line 2: In August 2011, the organization added a transitional home for men at 854 West High Street. The home had a capacity to house 6 clients plus a house coordinator. A women's transitional home (Ruth House), located on Strader Drive, was established in December 2011. Form, Part III, Line 3: In July 2011, the Life Renewal Program ceased to operate in order to eliminate duplicated services within Lexington, reduce organizational expenses, and provide transitional living services. Also, the New Circle Road Thrift Store was closed at the end of October 2011 to avoid projected financial losses due to scheduled rent increases and declining sales at that location.
