GRACE Foundation Matching Grants Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY

Employees

Active, full-time employees of W R Grace & Co, or one of its majority-owned subsidiaries, and current directors

Institutions

- Degree-granting U.S. and Canadian community and junior colleges, four-year colleges and universities, graduate and professional schools and secondary schools. The institutions must be accredited by one of the following Associations of Schools and Colleges (1) Middle States (2) New England (3) Central (4) Northwest (5) Southern (6) Western (7) Canada
- A fund, foundation or association which is an integral part of an approved school or college will be considered if the institution certifies that the gift will be applied directly to support its primary educational objectives and that contributions to it are deductible for federal income tax purposes
- Grace Foundation reserves the right to determine the eligibility of all schools for which matching gifts are requested. At the
 request of any eligible person, the Grace Foundation will determine an advance if a school gualifies for matching funds.
