Scholarship & Recognition Programs



Dear Student.

The Schwab-Rosenhouse Advisory Committee of the Jewish Federation of the Sacramento Region will award scholarships to high school students who live in the four counties in and around the Sacramento, CA metropolitan area, including El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, and Yolo Counties. The purpose of the Schwab-Rosenhouse Memorial Scholarship Program is to encourage deserving students to pursue their educational and career goals by providing funds to continue their studies beyond high school. Students planning to enroll at a four-year college or university, two-year junior or community college, or an accredited vocational/technical institution located within a 100-mile radius of Sacramento are invited to apply. Variable scholarship grants ranging from \$1,000 to \$3,500 will be awarded.

Students will enter the competition by completing the enclosed scholarship questionnaire. The questionnaire is designed to collect information about your academic interests, your family profile, and your school and community activities, as well as written responses to questions about current and future plans. In addition, a high school transcript, standardized test scores, and two letters of recommendation must be submitted. Financial need will be taken into consideration and Information to support that need will be requested from the finalists.

After completing the questionnaire and signing the Authorization/Certification on page 4, you should give it to a guidance counselor or school official who can confirm that you meet the program criteria and can report the data requested on page 4 of the questionnaire. The school official will sign the questionnaire, attach an official transcript and mail the materials to Scholarship & Recognition Programs in the envelope provided. You will be sent a postcard confirming receipt of your application.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by an appointed review committee, consisting of admission and financial aid professionals from institutions located in the Sacramento metropolitan area. The scholarship winners will be announced in May, after review of the financial need information.

Please keep the following in mind when completing the scholarship questionnaire:

- You must confirm that you are a high school senior who will graduate in the current academic year.
- Indicate the type of scholarship you are seeking. Students planning to begin a four-year college degree program at a community college should check the four-year college box.
- A list of high schools in the eligible geographic area is provided on the back of this letter. Refer to the listing and enter the code number in the boxes next to the school name.
- Standardized Test Scores (ACT or SAT) are required of students seeking the four-year college award. Your guidance counselor or school official may enter your test scores in the space provided on page 4 of the scholarship questionnaire, or you may have a score report sent directly to the scholarship program. Students should enter code 9982 on their ACT or SAT registration forms as a college or scholarship program to report scores to. If you have already taken the ACT or SAT, you may request an additional score report from the testing program's website (http://www.act.org and http://www.collegeboard.com, respectively). Enter code 9982 to report scores to the Schwab-Rosenhouse Scholarship Program.

Note: Students planning to study at a vocational/technical institution do not have to submit test scores unless scores are required for admission to the chosen program of study.

Letters of Recommendation - Applicants should arrange for the submission of two letters of recommendation to support their scholarship application. The first letter of recommendation should be provided by a guidance counselor, teacher, or school official who is familiar with your academic work. The second letter may come from a similar source, or from an adult employer, advisor, mentor or administrator who is familiar with your activities outside the classroom. Letters may be sent independently to the address below or enclosed with the questionnaire.

The application deadline is February 1. All application materials must be <u>postmarked</u> no later than February 1. Mail all application materials to:
