FIRST AMENDMENT OF CODE OF BYLAWS

The Code of Bylaws of Life Christian Education Foundation, a Washington nonprofit corporation, dated July 8, 2003 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following Bylaws of the Corporation:

ARTICLE I. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- Section 1. No Members. There shall be no members of this corporation.
- Section 2. <u>Number</u>. The corporation is governed by its Board of Directors. The number of directors may be changed from time to time by resolution of the Board, no decrease in the number shall have the effect of shortening the term of any director then in office.
- Section 3. <u>Qualifications</u>. Directors shall be of good report, sound Christian character and possess good business judgment. One director shall be an officer of First Assembly of God Life Center of Tacoma, Washington, a Washington nonprofit corporation ("Life Center Church"). Directors shall meet such additional qualifications as the Board may prescribe by resolution or by amendment to these Bylaws.
- Section 4. <u>Appointment of Directors</u>. The Board of Directors of the corporation shall nominate a slate of director candidates and deliver it to the Board of Directors of Life Center Church, and the slot for each director whose term is expiring shall be filled by appointment from such slate of nominees by the Board of Directors of Life Center Church.
- Section 5. <u>Terms of Office</u>. Directors shall serve terms of three years each, may serve two consecutive three year terms, and then rotate off of the board. They shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified.
- Section 6. <u>Committees</u>. The Board of Directors may designate and appoint by resolution adopted by majority of the directors one or more standing or temporary committees, in addition to the Executive Committee described below, each of which shall consist of two or more directors. Such committee or committees, to the extent provided in such resolution, shall have and exercise the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the corporation, subject to the limits of RCW 24.03.115 or similar statute. Except as otherwise provided, a majority of the number of directors composing any committee shall constitute a quorum, and the act of a majority of the committee members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the committee. Any committee member may be removed from committee by a majority vote of the Board.
- Section 7. <u>Resignation</u>. Any director may resign at any time by delivering notice to the president or the secretary, or by giving oral or written notice at any meeting of the Board of Directors. Any member of any committee may resign at any time by delivering notice thereof to the president, the secretary, or the chairperson of such committee, or by giving oral or written notice at any meeting of such committee. Any such resignation shall take effect at the time specified therein,

or if the time is not specified, upon delivery thereof and, unless otherwise specified therein, the acceptance of such resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.

- Section 8. <u>Removal</u>. Any one or more of the directors may be removed at any time by the Board of Directors of Life Center Church or by a vote of two-thirds of the directors of the corporation present at any regular meeting or at any special meeting called in whole or in part for that purpose.
- Section 9. <u>Vacancies</u>. In the event of a vacancy on the Board of Directors, a successor for each vacancy shall be appointed in accordance with the procedure in Section 4 to fill the unexpired term.
- Section 10. <u>Board Compensation</u>. The directors shall receive no compensation for their service as directors but may receive reimbursement for expenditures incurred on behalf of the corporation.
- Section 11. Quorum. A majority of the members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum.
- Section 12. <u>Annual Meeting</u>. The annual meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held during of the month of March or April. If in the judgment of the Board of Directors the meeting cannot be then held, it shall be held as soon as feasible thereafter. The Board of Directors may specify by resolution the time and place, either within or without the State of Washington, for holding any other regular meetings, which may be held without notice other than such resolution.
- Section 13. Special Meetings. Special meetings of the directors shall be held upon the call of the president or one-third of the Board of Directors. The notice of the meeting shall be in the form of a record and shall be sent at least two days prior to the meeting date. Notice of any meeting of the Board of Directors may be waived in a record by any director at any time or by a director's presence at the meeting, except where the director attends the meeting with the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened. Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the purpose of any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors or any committee designated by the Board of Directors need be specified in the notice or waiver of notices of such meeting unless required by these Bylaws.
- Section 14. <u>Voting</u>. Each director shall be entitled to cast one vote at any election or on any subject before any meeting of the Board.
- Section 15. <u>Participation by Telephone</u>. Directors of the corporation may participate in a meeting of the Board by means of a conference telephone or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other at the same time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at a meeting.
- Section 16. <u>Action Without a Meeting</u>. Any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting if a consent, in the form of a record, setting forth the action to be taken is executed by all of the directors. Any such consent shall be inserted in the minute book as if it were the minutes of a Board meeting.

Section 17. <u>Loans to Directors Prohibited</u>. No loans shall be made by the corporation to its directors. The directors who vote for or assent to the making of a loan to a director, and any officer or officers participating in the making of such loan, shall be jointly and severally liable to the corporation for the amount of such loan until the repayment thereof.

ARTICLE II. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- Section 1. The Executive Committee shall consist of the officers of the corporation and the immediate past president.
- Section 2. A majority of the members of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum, and a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the member of the Executive Committee at a meeting of the Executive Committee at which a quorum is present shall constitute an action of the Executive Committee.
- Section 3. The Executive Committee shall have and exercise the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the corporation, subject to the limits of RCW 24.03.115 or similar statute.
- Section 4. Meetings of the Executive Committee shall be held upon the call of any of its members. The notice of the meeting shall be in the form of a record and shall be sent at least one day prior to the meeting date.
- Section 5. Any action taken by the Executive Committee shall be reported to the Board at its next meeting.

ARTICLE III. OFFICERS

- Section 1. <u>In General</u>. The elected officers of the corporation shall be a president, a vice president, a secretary, a treasurer, and such other officers and assistant officers as may be deemed necessary by the Board of Directors. All of the officers must be directors. Each officer shall be annually elected by the Board at its annual meeting and shall serve until their successors are duly elected and qualified. Any two or more offices may be held by the same person, except the offices of president and secretary.
- Section 2. <u>President</u>. The president shall exercise the usual executive powers pertaining to the office of president, shall preside over meetings of the Board of Directors and shall perform other duties as assigned by the Board from time to time. The president may financially obligate the corporation without specific authority from the Board of Directors only up to a maximum amount of \$1,000. When this occurs, it shall be reported to the Board of Directors at its next meeting.
- Section 3. <u>Vice-President</u>. In the absence or disability of the president, and except as may be limited by resolution of the Board of Directors, the vice-president shall act as president, with all the powers of and subject to all the restrictions upon the president. The vice president shall perform other duties as assigned by the Board or by the president from time to time.
- Section 4. <u>Secretary</u>. The secretary shall perform all duties incident to the office of secretary and such other duties assigned by the Board of Directors or by the president from time to

time. The secretary shall keep records of the proceedings of the Board of Directors; see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws or as required by law; and act as custodian of the corporate records of the corporation.

- Section 5. <u>Treasurer</u>. The treasurer shall perform all duties incident to the office of treasurer and such other duties assigned by the Board of Directors or by the president from time to time. The treasurer shall have the care and custody of and be responsible for all funds and investments of the corporation, and shall cause to be kept regular books of account. The treasurer shall cause to be deposited all funds and other valuable effects in the name of the corporation in such depositories as may be designated by the Board of Directors.
- Section 6. Resignation. Any officer may resign at any time by delivering written notice to the president or the secretary, or by giving oral or written notice at any meeting of the Board of Directors. Any such resignation shall take effect at the time specified therein, or if the time is not specified, upon delivery thereof and, unless otherwise specified therein, the acceptance of such resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.
- Section 7. <u>Removal</u>. Any officer may be removed by the majority vote of the Board of Directors whenever in its judgment the best interests of the corporation will be served thereby. Removal by an officer who is also a director shall not have any effect on such person's status as a director. The removal of an officer shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the officer so removed. Election or appointment of an officer or agent shall not of itself create contract rights.
- Section 8. <u>Vacancies</u>. Vacancies in any office arising from any cause may be filled by the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting.
- Section 9. <u>Salaries</u>. The salaries of agents of the corporation shall be fixed by the Board of Directors.
- Section 10. <u>Checks</u>. Checks from any bank account of the corporation shall be signed only by such officers or agents as the Board of Directors may from time to time appoint by an appropriate resolution.
- Section 11. <u>Loans to Officers Prohibited</u>. No loans shall be made by the corporation to its officers. The directors who vote for or assent to the making of a loan to an officer, and any officer or officers participating in the making of such loan, shall be jointly and severally liable to the corporation for the amount of such loan until the repayment thereof.

ARTICLE IV. INDEMNIFICATION OF DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS

Section 1. <u>Power to Indemnify</u>. The corporation shall have the following powers:

Section 1.1 <u>Power to Indemnify</u>. The corporation may indemnify and hold harmless to the full extent permitted by applicable law each person who was or is made a party to or is threatened to be made a party to or is involved (including, without limitation, as a witness) in any actual or threatened action, suit or other proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or

investigative, and whether formal or informal (hereinafter a "proceeding"), by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation or, being or having been such a director, officer, employee or agent, he or she is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee, agent, trustee, or in any other capacity of another corporation or of a partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, including service with respect to employee benefit plans, whether the basis of such proceeding is alleged action or omission in an official capacity or in any other capacity while serving as a director, officer, employee, agent, trustee or in any other capacity, against all expense, liability and loss (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees, judgments, fines, ERISA excise taxes or penalties and amounts to be paid in settlement) actually or reasonably incurred or suffered by such person in connection therewith. Such indemnification may continue as to a person who has ceased to be a director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation and shall inure to the benefit of his or her heirs and personal representatives.

Section 1.2 <u>Power to Pay Expenses in Advance of Final Disposition</u>. The corporation may pay expenses incurred in defending any proceeding in advance of its final disposition (hereinafter "advancement of expenses"); provided, however, that any advancement of expenses shall be made to or on behalf of a director, officer, employee or agent only upon delivery to the corporation of: (a) a written affirmation of the director's, officer's, employee's or agent's good faith belief that he or she has met the standard of conduct described in RCW 23B.08.510; and (b) a written undertaking, by or on behalf of such director, officer, employee or agent, to repay all amounts so advanced if it shall ultimately be determined by final judicial decision from which there is no further right to appeal that such director, officer, employee or agent is not entitled to be indemnified under this Article or otherwise, which undertaking may be unsecured and may be accepted without reference to financial ability to make repayment.

Section 1.3 <u>Power to Enter Into Contracts</u>. The corporation may enter into contracts with any person who is or was a director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation in furtherance of the provisions of this Article and may create a trust fund, grant a security interest in property of the corporation, or use other means (including, without limitation, a letter of credit) to ensure the payment of such amounts as may be necessary to effect indemnification as provided in this Article.

Section 1.4 <u>Expansion of Powers</u>. If the Washington Business Corporation Act or the Washington Nonprofit Corporation Act is amended in the future to expand or increase the power of the corporation to indemnify, to pay expenses in advance of final disposition, to enter into contracts, or to expand or increase any similar or related power, then, without any further requirement of action by the directors of this corporation, the powers described in this Article shall be expanded and increased to the fullest extent permitted by the Washington Business Corporation Act and the Washington Nonprofit Corporation Act, as so amended.

Section 1.5 <u>Limitation of Powers</u>. No indemnification shall be provided under this Article to any such person if the corporation is prohibited by the Washington Business Corporation Act or other applicable law as then in effect from paying such indemnification. For example, no indemnification shall be provided to any person in respect of any proceeding, whether or not involving action in his or her official capacity, in which he or she shall have been finally adjudged to be liable on the basis of intentional misconduct or knowing violation of law by the

person, or from conduct of a director in violation of RCW 23B.08.310, or that the person personally received a benefit in money, property or services to which the person was not legally entitled.

Section 2. <u>Indemnification of Directors, Officers, Employees and Agents.</u>

- Section 2.1 <u>Directors</u>. The corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless any person who is or was a director of this corporation, and pay expenses in advance of final disposition of a proceeding, to the full extent to which the corporation is empowered.
- Section 2.2 <u>Officers, Employees, and Agents</u>. The corporation, by action of its Board of Directors, shall indemnify and hold harmless any person who is or was an officer, employee or agent of the corporation, and provide advancement of expenses to the full extent to which the corporation is empowered, or to any lesser extent which the Board of Directors may determine.
- Section 2.3 <u>Character of Rights</u>. To the extent the rights of indemnification and advancement of expenses have been conferred by or pursuant to this Article, such rights shall be contract rights.
- Section 2.4 <u>Enforcement</u>. A director, officer, employee or agent ("Claimant") shall be presumed to be entitled to indemnification and/or advancement of expenses under this Article upon submission of a written claim (and, in an action brought to enforce a claim for an advancement of expenses, where the undertaking in Section 1.2 above has been delivered to the corporation) and thereafter the corporation shall have the burden of proof to overcome the presumption that the Claimant is so entitled.
- Section 2.5 If a claim under this Article is not paid in full by the corporation within sixty (60) days after a written claim has been received by the corporation, except in the case of a claim for advancement of expenses, in which case the applicable period shall be twenty (20) days, the Claimant may at any time hereafter bring suit against the corporation to recover the unpaid amount of the claim. If successful in whole or in part, the Claimant shall also be entitled to be paid the expense of prosecuting such claim. Neither the failure of the corporation (including its Board of Directors or independent legal counsel) to have made a determination prior to the commencement of such action that indemnification of or advancement of expenses to the Claimant is proper in the circumstances nor an actual determination by the corporation (including its Board of Directors or independent legal counsel) that the Claimant is not entitled to indemnification or advancement of expenses shall be a defense to the action or create a presumption that the Claimant is not so entitled.
- Section 2.6 <u>Rights Not Exclusive</u>. The right to indemnification and advancement of expenses conferred in this Article shall not be exclusive of any other right which any person may have or hereafter acquire under any statute, provision of the Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws of the corporation, agreement, vote of disinterested directors, or otherwise.
- Section 3. <u>Insurance</u>. The corporation may purchase and maintain insurance, at its expense, to protect itself and any director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation or any person who, while a director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation, is or was a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, employee benefit plan or other enterprise against any expense, liability or loss, whether or not the

corporation would have the power to indemnify such person against such expense, liability or loss under the Washington Business Corporation Act.

- Section 4. <u>Survival of Benefits</u>. Any repeal or modification of this Article shall not adversely affect any right of any person existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
- Section 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Article or any application thereof shall be invalid, unenforceable or contrary to applicable law, the remainder of this Article, or the application of such provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid, unenforceable or contrary to applicable law, shall not be affected thereby and shall continue in full force and effect.
- Section 6. <u>Applicable Law</u>. For purposes of this Article, "applicable law" shall at all times be construed as the applicable law in effect at the date indemnification may be sought, or the law in effect at the date of the action, omission or other event giving rise to the situation for which indemnification may be sought, whichever is selected by the person seeking indemnification.

ARTICLE V. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

Section 1. <u>Fiscal Year</u>. The fiscal year of the corporation shall be determined by resolution adopted by the Board of Directors. In the absence of such a resolution, the fiscal year shall be the calendar year.

Section 2. Definitions.

"Deliver" means: (a) mailing; (b) transmission by facsimile equipment, for purposes of delivering a demand, consent, notice, or waiver to the corporation or one of its directors or officers; (c) electronic transmission, in accordance with the director's or officer's consent, for purposes of delivering a demand, consent, notice, or waiver to the corporation or one of its directors or officers under Section 3.

"Electronic transmission" means an electronic communication: (a) not directly involving the physical transfer of a record in a tangible medium and (b) that may be retained, retrieved, and reviewed by the sender and the recipient thereof, and that may be directly reproduced in a tangible medium by a sender and recipient.

"Execute," "executes," or "executed" means: (a) signed, with respect to a written record or (b) electronically transmitted along with sufficient information to determine the sender's identity, with respect to an electronic transmission.

"Record" means information inscribed on a tangible medium or contained in an electronic transmission.

"Tangible medium" means a writing, copy of a writing, facsimile, or a physical reproduction, each on paper or on other tangible material.

Any term not defined in these Bylaws shall have the definition in Chapter 24.03 RCW, as presently enacted or hereafter amended.

Section 3. <u>Electronic Notice</u>.

Section 3.1 <u>Consent to Electronic Notice</u>. In order to consent to notice via electronic transmission, a director or officer must, in a record, designate in the consent the appropriate electronic format and the address or system to which notices may be electronically transmitted, for example, specify an email address to which such electronic transmission may be sent.

Section 3.2 Revocation of Consent to Electronic Notice. A director or officer who has consented to receipt of electronically transmitted notices may revoke the consent by delivering a revocation to the corporation, in the form of a record (sent to the attention of the secretary). Additionally, the consent of any director or officer is revoked if the corporation is unable to electronically transmit two consecutive notices given by the corporation in accordance with the consent, and this inability becomes known to the secretary of the corporation or other person responsible for giving the notice. The inadvertent failure by the corporation to treat this inability as a revocation does not invalidate any meeting or other action.

Section 3.3 <u>Effective Date of Delivery</u>. If notice is mailed, it shall be deemed delivered when deposited in the mail properly addressed to the director or officer at his or her address as it appears on the records of the corporation with postage thereon prepaid. If the notice is by electronic transmission, it shall be deemed delivered when it is transmitted electronically in accordance with the consent of the director or officer. All other notice in tangible medium shall be deemed delivered upon receipt.

Section 4. <u>Amendment of Bylaws</u>. A two-thirds vote of the directors present at any meeting of the Board (provided the directors were notified before the meeting that an amendment or amendments would be considered at the meeting) and the approval of the Board of Directors of Life Center Church is required for an amendment of these Bylaws.
