STATEMENT 10

PART VII-B LINE 1A(1):

THE MERAUX FOUNDATION RECEIVED ASSETS BY A BEQUEST FROM THE SUCCESSION OF ARLENE MERAUX. PRIOR TO THIS TRANSFER THERE WERE TWO PIECES OF REAL ESTATE THAT WERE LEASED BY ARLENE MERAUX TO A PERSON WHO LATER BECAME A BOARD MEMBER OF THE MERAUX FOUNDATION. IN ORDER TO EXERCISE ITS FIDUCIARY DUTY WITH REGARDS TO THIS PERCEIVED CONFLICT, THE BOARD OF THE MERAUX FOUNDATION HIRED OUTSIDE LEGAL COUNSEL TO ENFORCE ITS RIGHTS UNDER THE LEASES AND GOT APPRAISALS BY INDEPENDENT REAL ESTATE EXPERTS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE LEASE ARRANGEMENTS WERE AT FAIR MARKET VALUE. ONE LEASE HAS PAID FAIR MARKET VALUE RENTS FOR THE ENTIRE LEASE PERIOD. FOR THE OTHER LEASE THE FOUNDATION'S LEGAL COUNSEL IS PRESENTLY WORKING TO DETERMINE THE FULL AMOUNT OWED TO IT AND WILL TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTIONS TO ENFORCE THE FOUNDATION'S RIGHTS.

IN ADDITION, THE BOARD MEMBER WITH THE PERCEIVED CONFLICT OF INTEREST RESIGNED FROM THE BOARD OF THE MERAUX FOUNDATION.

PART VII-B LINE LA(3):

MERAUX FOUNDATION PAYS COMPENSATION TO ITS DIRECTORS FOR THEIR WORK IN MANAGING THE OPERATIONS OF THE FOUNDATION. THE MERAUX FOUNDATION DIFFERS FROM MOST PRIVATE FOUNDATIONS THAT MERELY MAKE GRANTS FROM THEIR INVESTMENT INCOME. ITS EXTENSIVE LAND HOLDINGS REQUIRE A GREAT DEAL OF OVERSIGHT, INCLUDING EXECUTING LEASE AND MINERAL CONTRACTS, ARRANGING FOR REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE, COLLECTING REVENUES, PAYING REAL ESTATE TAXES, ETC. IN ADDITION, THEY SPEND A GREAT DEAL OF TIME RESPONDING TO REQUESTS AND SOLICITATIONS FOR DONATIONS.

BOARD MEMBERS DOCUMENT THE TIME THEY SPEND HANDLING THE MERAUX FOUNDATION'S WORK SO THE COMPENSATION THEY ARE PAID IS WITHIN THE FAIR MARKET VALUE FOR THE SERVICES RENDERED.

ORGANIZATION'S MISSION:

THE MISSION OF THE MERAUX FOUNDATION IS TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE PEOPLE OF ST. BERNARD PARISH - FROM MEDICAL CARE TO EDUCATION TO RECREATION.

JOSEPH AND ARLENE MERAUX WERE ONE OF THE LARGEST LANDOWNERS IN THE HISTORY OF ST. BERNARD PARISH. AFTER THEIR DEATHS THEIR PROPERTIES WERE CONTRIBUTED TO THE ARLENE AND JOSEPH MERAUX FOUNDATION TO BENEFIT THE PEOPLE OF ST. BERNARD PARISH. MOST PRIVATE FOUNDATIONS MAKE GRANTS FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES FROM EARNINGS GENERATED BY THEIR INVESTMENTS. THESE DIVERSE LAND TYPES POSE COMPLEX CHALLENGES IN THE PRESERVATION, USE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.

LOOKING AHEAD, THE MERAUX FOUNDATION IS COMMITTED TO PARISH IMPROVEMENTS UTILIZING SMART GROWTH AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PRINCIPLES. POTENTIAL IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE COMMUNITY FACILITIES, PARKWAYS, BIKEWAYS, RECREATION, RESTORATION OF HISTORIC BUILDINGS AND SITES, SCENIC AREAS, MUSEUMS, BATTLEFIELDS, ARCHEOLOGICAL SITES, WATER SPORTS, SPECIAL EVENTS, AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY, RANCHING, SOLAR AND WINDMILL FARMS.
