#### Purpose

The Charles Lamar Family Foundation's vision for Baton Rouge is a cadre of stable nonprofit organizations that effect positive change in the community. The Foundation seeks to support emerging or maturing and expanding nonprofits with useful missions that are responsive to community challenges and opportunities. Funding is intended to support organizations that can demonstrate their capacity with viable operating plans and the retention of talented and dedicated personnel.

#### **Grant Procedure**

Organizations applying for grants should draft a proposal using the following checklist.

Proposal Summary: Use form attached.

Narrative Section: The application should be concise and should include the following information:
