ACCI only provides funds to organizations that are registered nonprofit organizations under their home countries' laws ACCI only provides funds to organizations with which it enters into written agreements specifying the expectations and duties of both parties. Those agreements contain requirements that the receiving organizations must report to ACCI how all funds are used, and in those agreements, ACCI maintains the right to discontinue the relationship at any time the receiving organization does not comply with the reporting requirements, or if the funds are not used according to ACCI's exempt purposes. ACCI monitors the reports, and when possible, it sends representatives to visit the receiving organizations and report on how funds are being used. Part I, Line 3, Section (1), Column (e), AND Part II, Line 1, Section (1), Column (d): ACCI is a "friend of" a Canadian organization that is also called Adventive Cross Cultural Initiatives. The organizations are separate, and each has an independent board of directors, but the organizations work together in many ways. Both send contracted missionaries throughout the world to promote the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and both support similar Christian organizations that share the same beliefs and ministry objectives. Both boards try to meet together, and where possible, the organizations try to utilize resources in the most efficient manner possible. ACCI-Canada sends money to ACCI-US throughout the year to support ACCI-US ministries, and ACCI-US sends money to ACCI-Canada to support its ministries. (As reported elsewhere in this Form 990 and its Schedules, in 2011, ACCI-Canada donated \$65,042 to ACCI-US for its ministry projects, and ACCI-US donated \$28,519 to ACCI-Canada for its ministry projects. These ministry projects include world-wide evangelism, church planting and support, practical physical support and relief for the poor, and support of other Christian ministries doing similar work in other countries. Part I, Line 3, Section (2), Column (e): In 2011, ACCI contributed to a Canadian charity that ministered to the homeless and First Nations people in Thunder Bay, Ontario, Canada.
