PROGRAM WITH A CONTRIBUTION OF \$61,000. IT WILL CONSIDER THESE CONTRIBUTIONS ANNUALLY. THESE FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS ARE DESIGNED TO ASSIST THESE EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES TO PRODUCE/EDUCATE MORE REGISTERED NURSES FOR ALTUS AND SOUTHWESTERN OKLAHOMA.

DURING THE 2011 FISCAL YEAR, JCMH HEALTH CARE CORPORATION CONTRIBUTED OVER \$12,000 TO THE JACKSON COUNTY FREE CLINIC, WHICH IS TO BE USED TO PURCHASE PRESCRIPTION DRUGS NEEDED FOR PATIENTS SEEN AT THIS CLINIC. THIS IS THE EIGHTH YEAR CONTRIBUTIONS HAVE BEEN MADE TO THIS EFFORT, AND THE BOARD IS COMMITTED TO HELP FUND THIS CLINIC'S OPERATIONS ON AN ONGOING BASIS.

FINALLY, JCMH HEALTH CARE CORPORATION CONTINUES TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE SERVICES THROUGH ITS SCANNER SERVICE AND ITS ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY. THESE ENTITIES CONTINUE TO PROVIDE NEEDED SERVICES TO THE RESIDENTS OF SOUTHWESTERN OKLAHOMA AND NORTH TEXAS.
