### Explanation to Schedule A, Part II. Section C. Question 17A

Question 17A requests that we submit an explanation of how Butterfield Memorial Foundation ("Butterfield") meets the "facts and circumstances test" in support of continuing our status as a publicly supported organization described in Sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) of the Internal Revenue Code. Butterfield has a continuous and bona fide program for solicitation of funds from the public, its governing board is public in nature in that the entire board is comprised of community and religious leaders and its facilities and programs are publicly available and serve a critical public need.

### **Public Mission**

Butterfield is a ministry of the Free Methodist Church of North America, is voluntarily affiliated with the Free Methodist Church of North America, and operates in a manner that is consistent with the doctrines, principles, and practices of the Free Methodist Church of North America contained in its Book of discipline. Butterfield is recognized as a social services agency of the Free Methodist Church of North America. As a social services agency, the Free Methodist Church requires that a majority of the members of the board of directors of Butterfield must be members of the Free Methodist Church. Its Chief Executive Officer must also be a member of the Free Methodist Church. Butterfield is subject to the rules, regulations and the Book of the Discipline of the Free Methodist Church of North America as from time to time adopted by the General Conference of the Church, insofar as such rules, regulations and the Book of Discipline do not contravene federal or state laws or regulations.

Butterfield conducts several programs as part of its public mission. One program is Deaconess Pregnancy and Adoption Services. It was founded in 1900 well before the Oklahoma Territory became a state. It is now the largest non-profit adoption agency in Oklahoma. Deaconess Pregnancy and Adoption Services is a social service agency of the Free Methodist Church of North America and its purpose is charitable and religious in nature. It promotes the good health and strength of families by its unconditional acceptance of women in crisis due to unplanned pregnancy, improving the homes of children, facilitating the adoption of children, assisting adoptive parents in the creation of their family and providing crisis intervention and counseling services.

Another program Butterfield conducts is its operation of the Open Arms Free Clinic. The Clinic was founded in 1993 and is currently one of the largest charitable medical clinics in Oklahoma City. The Open Arms Free Clinic is a collaborative effort among Butterfield, the Free Methodist Church, the Oklahoma Medical Society, and Deaconess Hospital. The Clinic is very much a community effort with volunteer doctors provided by the Oklahoma County Medical Society, support services from Deaconess Hospital and nursing volunteers from a number of local nursing schools. The Open Arms Free Clinic is located at the 5013 N. Meridian Avenue and offers patients a calm setting for their spiritual and physical healing. Ministers are available to assist patients with prayer and spiritual guidance. The Open Arms Free Clinic serves and ministers to the medically uninsured and disadvantaged residents of Oklahoma County by providing medically necessary, free, clinic-based health care, education, and spiritual encouragement. The Open Arms Free Clinic treats acute illnesses, infections, colds, and flu. During

'2011 the clinic processed 1,666 patient visits and is now expanding so as to be at a 5,000 patient visits/year rate by 2012.

Other programs Butterfield conducts include education programs, leadership development programs, and board matching programs.

### **Fundraising Program**

Butterfield has a continuous and bona fide program for solicitations of funds from the general public. Butterfield's fundraising efforts have been focused on several areas depending upon the specific program for which it is raising funds. Its fundraising efforts include annual mailings. Each year Butterfield sends three annual campaign mailings following a special event mailing and match campaign mailing. It also sends newsletters to update donors and volunteers on program activities. Last year Butterfield received contributions from approximately 300 donors. Butterfield also makes presentations to targeted groups promoting financial support for Deaconess Home and the Open Arms Clinic. Butterfield is also active in community activities to improve its community networking and donor relations. Butterfield also employs a development specialist whose focus is fundraising for our programs. The development specialist frequently attends special events promoting the vision and mission, meets frequently with individual donors and with various members of the media in the Oklahoma City area to promote the services and programs.

None of the members of the Board would be classified as substantial contributors. Instead, as evidenced by a brief description of each Board member's profession, Butterfield's Board of Directors is comprised of people who are active in the community and share Butterfield's mission as a social services agency for the Free Methodist Church. As a social services ministry, Butterfield's bylaws require that at least 51% Board members are members of various Free Methodist Churches. As a result, 10 of the 16 Board members are members of various Free Methodist Churches. Although those individuals have a common church affiliation, they represent various backgrounds. Diverse backgrounds and varied strengths give Butterfield sound leadership for decision-making, fundraising, and guidance.

As discussed above, Butterfield satisfies the criteria listed in the facts and circumstances test because it has a continuous and bona fide program for solicitation of funds, its governing board is public in nature in that all of the Board members are community leaders and represent a broad cross section of the community and its facilities and programs are publicly available and serve a critical public need. As a result, we respectfully request that Butterfield's status as a publicly-supported organization described in Sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) be continued.
