### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

To establish guidelines for awarding of the annual UMC/TMC Scholarship Program to UMC employees and their dependents. The TMC will award (15) \$1,000 and (10) \$500 scholarships for each academic year (September through August). Students enrolled for >12.0 college credit hours will be eligible for up to \$1,000 scholarship and students enrolled <12.0 college credit hours will be eligible for \$500 scholarship. The scholarship application enrollment period is June 1<sup>st</sup> through July 1<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year.

### I. TEXT:

Guidelines/requirements of the scholarship application:

The scholarship is open to all UMC employees and their dependents. A dependent is defined as a spouse, child, stepchild, or legal custody of grandchildren or other children related by blood or marriage. (See Attachment #1 for a copy of the application)

An applicant may receive a total of two scholarships for separate academic years. An application is required for each academic year.

There may be only one scholarship awarded per family at any given time.

The scholarship is open to accredited undergraduate and graduate degree plans.

The applicant must have a current GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Current GPA is the last college semester's GPA or GPA from high school whichever is most recent. An official transcript (most recent semester) must be included with the scholarship application.

The applicant must submit an essay on "Why should you be considered for this scholarship?" The essay must be typed in 300 - 500 words. The applicant should not include identifying information in the essay.

The applicant must submit 2 reference letters: one from a recent teacher, professor, or supervisor, and one from a person of the applicant's choice. Identifying information will be removed prior to review by the scholarship committee.

### **Application Availability**

Applications are available on the UMC intranet (Click on Resources, forms, TMC application) or may be obtained in Human Resources in the basement, Nurse Recruitment on the third floor and the foundation office on the first floor.

Applications for the TMC scholarship will be accepted in the Foundation Office each calendar year from June 1<sup>st</sup> through July 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **Selection Process:**

All applications will be reviewed for completeness by the Vice Chair-Scholarship. The Vice Chair-Scholarship will complete a "Scholarship Checklist" (see attachment #2) to confirm that all requirements of the application have been met. In the event the applicant does not include the required documents per requested per TMC application, the applicant will be automatically disqualified.

Each application will be assigned a number by the Vice Chair-Scholarship and have all other identifying information removed from the application in order to assure anonymity.

The TMC Executive Committee members will individually review all applications provided to them by the Vice Chair - Scholarship. Each committee member will decide which scholarship applications (identified by number) are the highest in quality.

Considerations for scholarship approval may include but are not limited to the following:

- o GPA (Cumulative and most recent completed semester)
- o Quality of application essay and supportive reference letters
- o Additional financial support secured from University Medical Center
- o Application completeness and content
- o Full time or part-time student status

Each member of the TMC Executive committee will select the top 25 candidates (identified per number) they feel are deserving of a scholarship award. The Vice Chair-Scholarship will abstain from voting. The twenty applicants receiving the most number of votes will be award a TMC scholarship.

Each applicant will be notified of approval or denial after TMC Executive Committee has reviewed all submitted applications. (See attachments #3, #4, #5)

### Procedures for Awarding the UMC/TMC Scholarship Program

### Purpose:

In recognition of the dedicated service of UMC employees, the Thirty Minute Club is pleased to have established a scholarship programs for UMC employees and their dependents (See Policy #FD-30-5). The following will detail the procedures for the UMC/TMC Scholarship Program and its Guidelines/Requirements.

### Guidelines/requirements of the scholarship program:

- 1. The scholarship program is open to all UMC employees with more than one year of tenure and their dependents. A dependent is defined as child, stepchild, or legal custody of grandchildren or other children related by blood or marriage.
- 2. The Thirty Minute Club will award a minimum of (15) \$1,000 scholarships and (10) \$500 scholarships for the 2011- 2012 academic year (September through August).
- 3. An applicant may receive a total of two scholarships for separate academic years. An application is required for each academic year.
- 4. Applications for the TMC scholarship will be accepted in the Foundation Office each calendar year from June 1<sup>st</sup> through July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 5. Students enrolled for 12.0 or more (undergraduate) or 9 or more (graduate) college hours will be eligible for a scholarship up to \$1,000, and students enrolled for < 12.0 (undergraduate) and < 9 (graduate) college hours will be eligible for a scholarship up to \$500.
- 6. There may be only one scholarship awarded per family at any given time.
- 7. The scholarship is open to accredited undergraduate and graduate degree plans.
- 8. The applicant must have a current cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher on a 4.0 scale. A transcript (most recent semester) must be included with the scholarship application.

- 9. The scholarship committee will review applications without knowledge of the applicant's name or other identifying information.
- 10. The applicant must submit an essay on "Why I should be considered for this scholarship?" The essay must be typed and 300 500 words. The applicant should not include identifying information in the essay.
- 11. The applicant must submit 2 reference letters: one from a recent teacher, instructor, or supervisor and one from a person of the applicant's choice. Identifying information will be deleted prior to review by the scholarship committee.
- 12. Considerations for scholarship approval may include but are not limited to the following:
  - o GPA (Cumulative and most recent completed semester)
  - o Quality of application essay and supportive reference letters
  - o Additional financial support secured from University Medical Center
  - o Application completeness and content
  - o Full-time or part-time student status
- 13. The Scholarship Committee will review the applications and complete the Scholarship Score card points for GPA, Undergraduate vs. Graduate and Additional UMC Funding. The TMC Executive Committee members will complete the Scholarship Score card points for Strength of Essay and Strength of Recommendation letters.
- 14. Based upon the number of points each applicant receives, the TMC Executive committee will select the candidates receiving the highest number of points. The number of applicants selected will be based upon the number of scholarships being awarded. The Scholarship Committee will abstain from voting.
- 15. **Payment:** Each applicant will be notified of approval or denial after the TMC Executive Committee has reviewed all submitted applications. A check will be made for the designated amount approved and made payable to both the student and the college of attendance. The scholarship check will be mailed directly to the approved applicant's home address. It will be the responsibility of each approved applicant to submit the scholarship check to the financial aid office at their college of attendance.
