RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

TREACY FOUNDATION

The duly approved Restated Articles of Incorporation ("Articles") of the Treacy Foundation, a Montana nonprofit corporation (hereinafter, the "Foundation"), are as set forth below.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Foundation shall be the Treacy Foundation.

ARTICLE II - TYPE OF NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The Foundation shall be a nonprofit corporation organized pursuant to the Montana Nonprofit Corporation Act as a public benefit corporation.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

Unless otherwise determined by the Foundation's Board of Directors, the principal office of the Foundation shall be located at 318 E. Sixth Ave, Helena, Montana, 59601 and its mailing address shall be P.O. BOX 1479, Helena, Montana 59624.

The registered agent of the Foundation shall be Kimmy Skiftun. The registered agent's office is located at 318 E. Sixth Ave, Helena, Montana, 59601 and its mailing address shall be P.O. BOX 1479, Helena, Montana 59624.

ARTICLE IV- PURPOSE

The Foundation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes as specified in Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to the organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(C)(3) on the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

In fulfilling this charitable purpose, the Foundation shall support and strengthen nonprofit taxexempt organizations in our community by awarding financial grants and provide financial assistance through scholarships to students pursuing a higher education.

In so doing, the Foundation shall have the power, directly or indirectly, alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, to do any and all lawful acts which may be necessary or convenient to effect the charitable purposes for which the Foundation is organized, and to aid or assist other organizations or persons whose activities further accomplish, foster, or attain such purposes.

ARTICLE V - EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, at all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the Foundation:

 No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to directors, officers, or private persons, except the Foundation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

2. No substantial part of the activities of the Foundation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the Foundation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf

of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

3. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the Foundation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future tax code, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

4. If and to the extent the Foundation is deemed to be a private foundation as defined in Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, the Foundation shall also be subject to the

restrictions described at Mont. Code Ann. § 35-2-127.

ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Foundation shall have no members.

The management of the affairs of the Foundation shall be vested in a board of directors, as described by the Foundation's Bylaws. No director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the Foundation.

The number of directors constituting the current board of directors is five (5). Their names and addresses are as follows:

ARTICLE VII -- LIABILITY LIMITATION

No officer or director of the Foundation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of the Foundation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of debts or obligations of the Foundation.

ARTICLE VIII - DURATION/DISSOLUTION

The duration of the corporate existence for the Foundation shall be perpetual unless dissolved in accordance with law.

Upon dissolution of the Foundation, its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Foundation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
