The largest component is \$22,333,006 towards the completion of ta Elephant Passage, as part of the Millennium plan. Expenditures for this \$50M capital project are expensed since the City and County of Denver will own the se upon completion in 2012. Approximately \$1,300,000 of this expense is associated with the refurbishment of the Northern Shores cafe and the surrounding. The cafe was upgraded with a new kitchen and equipment. A playground was built next to the cafe with a subarctic landscape theme that incorporates a single feature and an interactive water feature. Smaller capital projects include critical investments in equipment and facilities to maintain the Zoo. We have strategically sought collaborations with partners that have earned rust of underrepresented audiences. In 2011, approximately 50,000 students participated in on-site classes, assemblies, science workshops, career programs, in popular Bunk with the Beasts program, Summer Safari (a day camp) and other programs. This number does not include students who visited the zoo on field 85,479 children and adults participated in education outreach programming, primarily Pre-K through 12th grade students.
