The summative assessment begins approximately two months before the anniversary date of employment of the Executive Director. The Board Chair asks the Executive Director to write a self-evaluation that describes progress during the preceding year as related to the goals and objectives of the strategic plan, At the same time, the Board Chair solicits feedback and imput from all Board members, and also requests information from staff and key volunteers as appropriate. The Executive Director then meets one-on-one with the Board Chair to discuss both the self-evaluation and the Board feedback. After this session, the board chair convenes the Executive Committee of the Board for a formal performance review. Part of this session is "Executive Session" during which the Executive Director is asked to leave the room so that the committee members can discuss the Executive Director privately. The Executive Committee then prepares a recommendation for either retention or termination of the Executive Director and presents it to the full Board. The Executive Director then meets with the full Board to discuss performance, followed by an "Executive Session" during which the Executive Director is asked to leave the roomso that the full Board can discuss the recommendations. The full Board conducts a formal vote on the recommendation (along with any changes proposed) as presented by the Executive Committee. The Board Chair then commun
