## AWARD DETAILS AND RESTRICTIONS:

THE GOAL OF THE REDUCE YOUR USE GRANTS IS TO PROVIDE NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION WITH THE RESOURCES TO IMPLEMENT ENERGY-SAVING MEASURES THAT WILL REDUCE ENERGY COSTS. GRANTS UP TO \$5,000 CAN BE AWARDED. REDUCING ENERGY USE HELPS NON-PROFITS ORGANIZATIONS DECREASE ENERGY BILLS, THEREFORE ALLOWING FOR MORE FUNDS TO BE USED ON THE ORGANIZATIONS MISSION-BASED PROGRAMS.


