There are several portions of the Form 990-EZ that will be addressed.

Some are descriptive and some are required financial details and explanations.

We will begin with the descriptive aspects, as they will provide necessary context.

Initial Activities of the Organization

The Paul Basch Memorial Foundation ("PBMF", or "the Foundation") was incorporated as an Arizona nonprofit corporation on April 6, 2001; formed by George Basch in memory of his son, Paul Basch, who suffered from severe depression and took his own life on May 15, 1998.

The intent, upon formation, was to provide public education, research and resources broadly related to depression and mental illness in general.

The foundation was dormant until late 2005 when it embarked on a project to provide nutritional supplementary foods for undernourished children in Africa with the intent of providing a healthy life-start what would help ward off depression in later years.

Numerous structural and administrative hurdles, which could not be overcome, caused this program to be abandoned.

The key lesson learned from this effort was that any program of this small, publically funded, organization had to have minimal overhead so that resources could be devoted directly to programs.

Activities from 2010

This description is responsive to the information requested in Part V - Line 33

After researching various options we embarked, in early 2010, on the Himalayan Stove Project.

See http://himalayanstoveproject.org for additional details.

As our website indicates: "The Himalayan Stove Project is dedicated to preserving the Himalayan environment and improving the health of the people living in the trans-Himalayan region. We provide clean cookstoves to individuals and families living in the Himalayas who now cook with traditional, rudimentary cookstoves or over open fire pits inside their homes, consuming excessive amounts of precious

fuel and polluting the indoor air to dangerously unhealthy levels. Our goal is to deliver 10,000 clean cookstoves within five years."

This program began with a pilot shipment of 48 stoves in late 2010 to test the viability of the concept.

George Basch, President of the Foundation, spent two months in Nepal in April and May 2011, at his own expense, to survey and evaluate the acceptance of the cookstoves.

The local collaborators with whom PBMF is working with in Nepal inventoried their local geographic areas to determine need, and came up with 4,000 stoves.

The first container load of 1,539 is on its way to Kathmandu and should arrive by the end of February 2012.

George Basch will return to Nepal at the end of March 2012 to be involved in the distribution process and assess further development of the program.

The specific direct impact during 2011 has been limited in terms of the direct number of people helped – 2011 has been a developmental year. The impact of the 2011 work will become apparent in 2012 and subsequent years.

Our current fund-raising literature describes the program as follows:

The Himalayan Stove Project is a humanitarian/philanthropic project dedicated to preserving the Himalayan environment and improving the health of the people living in the trans-Himalayan region.

We provide free, clean-burning, highly fuel-efficient cook stoves to individuals and families living in the trans-Himalayan Region who now cook with traditional, rudimentary stoves or over open fire pits inside their homes, consuming excessive amounts of precious fuel and polluting the indoor air to dangerously unhealthy levels.

As noted above, our goal is to deliver 10,000 "free" stoves within five years.

Replacing open cooking fires and inefficient stoves in remote villages furthers our goals to improve health and quality of life and to reduce environmental damage in this fragile and sensitive ecosystem.

Health is improved by reducing indoor air pollution (the fourth largest global health problem according to the World Health Organization); the health of the environment is protected by reducing de-forestation and further, by reducing carbon emissions.

Quality of life is improved by reducing the amount of time families spend in the endless task of foraging for fuel.

Our stoves burn wood or other natural, locally obtained fuel, but fuel use is reduced by as much as 80% from traditional stoves.

Our motto is: "For \$100 change the life of a family."

We collaborate with local non-governmental organizations (NGO's) in Nepal and Bhutan who hand-carry the stoves to remote, road-less villages, which also provides employment for local people.

Our collaborators include The Himalayan Trust (Sir Edmund Hillary's charitable foundation); Community Action Nepal (Doug Scott and Chris Bonington); the former Royal Family of Mustang, The Mountain Institute and T-Help in Nepal, and Bridge to Bhutan.

This is an ambitious program, which will require substantial public funding to carry out in a meaningful fashion, consistent with our goals, and the public nature of the foundation.

Like any venture – private or charitable – start-up funding is required.

Mr. Basch has advanced, as no-interest loans (memorialized in a agreements with the Foundation) \$5,160 in 2010 and \$63,710 in 2011 in order to finance the fabrication, delivery and distribution of the first container-load of stoves mentioned above. These funds have been supplemented by successful initial fundraising efforts in 2010 and 2011 (\$7,470 and \$18,750 respectively).

"Other Assets" are the payments made for the fabrication of stovepipes/chimneys and for partial payment for a shipping container, containing 1,539 stoves and 1,380 2-pot accessories for the stoves.

Further expenditures will be required during 2012 for final payments for the stovepipes and the stoves and accessories and for transportation, warehousing and physical distribution to the ultimate recipients of the stoves.

Liabilities during 2011 increased by \$63,710 from \$5,160 to \$68,870, reflecting additional loans to the organization as described in Schedule L.
