Immigration - HCMU began its legal immigration program in 2000 after receiving reports about predatory organizations that provided impossible guarantees for success while charging exorbitant prices. HCMU provides affordable and high-quality legal services and consultations both in Salt Lake City and throughout the state of Utah. The majority of our clients are women and families who have experienced domestic violence or other violent crimes. We help them escape the cycle of violence and become contributing members of the community by helping them gain legal residency and starting them on a pathway toward success. In 2011, we managed 2,503 cases, adding 1,671 new clients.

Education - HCMU's education department provides school readiness, after-school and summer programs for low-income minority students in Park City and Wendover, Utah. Families served generally lack opportunities for extracurricular activities. Our programs in partnership with United Way, Tooele and Park City School Districts provide high-quality enrichment programs, tutoring and education, physical activities and arts education to ensure that these children stay active, motivated and confident. We also offer parent education classes to help families become more involved with their children's schooling. In 2011 we served over 300 families and their children. Promotoras/Outreach - the promotoras outreach program is one of HCMU's long-standing innovations. The promotoras share a common background and language with our clients and their bilingual and bicultural services are imperative in our efforts to ensure the well-being of Utah's vulnerable populations. The promotoras provide a wide range of services across Salt Lake, Summit and Tooele counties, including weekly professional prenatal classes in a variety of locations; education on healthy lifestyles and other issues of concern for mothers; assistance with applications for insurance and government aid; individual life skills consultations; referrals to counseling programs and/or clinics; support groups for families of special needs children; and ongoing

Our Parish Health program is determined to help poor and vulnerable individuals access the health care they need. In addition, we provide pastoral services and bereavement counseling for individuals who have faced severe trauma or lost family members. In 2011 the program provided 3,624 tests, 103 referrals and 320 reduced-cost flu shots.
