The Bureau also provides inspection and quality marking services to ISPM 15 compliant export wood packaging through its Wood Packaging Material (WPM) program. Pacific Lumber Inspection Bureau also publishes and distributes the "Export "R" List Grading and Dressing Rules" for export lumber.
