- 5) Our range of grants is from \$1.000 to \$10,000, with our average around \$3,500. Multi-year grants will be considered only after a group has first qualified and received funding for an initial year.
- 6) We generally follow the "5-50" rule, rarely funding groups where our support is less than 5% or more than 50% of their annual budget.
