Schedule O - Supplemental Information

Go and Tell, Inc. ("Go and Tell") is an Oregon nonprofit corporation established on January 12, 2000. Go and Tell was formed to own and operate a small Christian broadcasting station in Medford, Oregon. It took approximately ten (10) years for the Board of Directors of Go and Tell to obtain the required licensing and permits for a radio station. During this period, Go and Tell had no income, no expenses, no assets and no liabilities.

Go and Tell filed for tax-exempt status shortly after formation requesting tax-exempt status as a charitable organization described in IRC §501(c)(3) and classification as a public charity for income tax purposes. Go and Tell lost its exemption for failure to file returns for a period of three consecutive years.

The Board of Directors of Go and Tell, Inc. retained Carol P. Schaner of Gordon & Rees LLP, exempt organization counsel, to prepare a new Form 1023 Application for Recognition of Exemption for Go and Tell. After reviewing the funding sources of Go and Tell, counsel recommended that Go and Tell re-apply for tax-exempt status as a charitable organization described in IRC §501(c)(3) and private operating foundation described in IRC §4942(j)(3). The Board of Directors worked closely with counsel in connection with the preparation and filing of the new Form 1023 Application for Recognition for Exemption, which is currently pending with the Internal Revenue Service.
