•	The Economics of Happiness film project: We completed final editing and launched this documentary film in January. The launch
-	included premieres in Seattle, Portland, Berkeley, Toronto, New York City, London, Seoul, Hong Kong, and Tokyo. At each of these
-	launch events, the film was followed by panel discussions that included members of "partner" NGOs as well as one or more of the
-	thinkers/activists featured in the film. Among the organizations that co-sponsored the launch events were Post Carbon Institute,
-	Yes! Magazine, Buddhist Peace Fellowship, Food First, New Economics Institute, local Transition Town chapters, and many others.
_	Following the initial launch, we encouraged local community groups to organize their own screenings based on a similar model,
_	with opportunities for discussion following the film. Over 250 such screenings were held in North America during 2011, as well as
_	70 in Europe, 216 in Asia, and 58 in Australia / New Zealand. We also produced a DVD of the film, created streaming opportunities
_	for colleges and universities, and began work on translating the film into non-English languages. By year's end there were versions
_	available in French, German, Flemish, Japanese, Czech, Italian, Spanish, and Turkish. We also entered the film in numerous film
	festivals, earning Best in Show at Cinema Verde, Best Director from EKOFilm 2011 (Czech Republic), Award of Merit from
	Accolade Film Competition, and a Bronze Award from the Oregon Film Awards.

-	Educational Outreach: Through books, videos, lectures, reports, conferences, classes, interviews and web-based materials, we
-	inform the public of the many costs of globalization, and the systemic benefits of economic localization. The launch of The
-	Economics of Happiness film opened up many new opportunities to bring ISEC's message into the public's eye. Numerous inter-
_	views of Producer/co-director Helena Norberg-Hodge appeared in print, radio, television, and online, including CNBC, GritTV, and the
-	Cindy Sheehan program. While Helena Norberg-Hodge and co-director Steven Gorelick appeared in person to lead discussions
_	following films in many locations, the use of Skype Q&A sessions after screenings greatly expanded the number of people who were
-	able to see and hear ISEC staff. In Korea, translations of several ISEC publications were produced and released, including both
-	adult and children's versions of Helena Norberg-Hodge's book, Ancient Futures. The Roots of Change study group program also
-	benefited from the publicity surrounding The Economics of Happiness film, with groups forming in North America, Australia, India,
-	and Europe.

•	Ladakh programs: In 2011, we continued our efforts over more than three decades to counter unsustainable development in this
-	Himalayan region. It was also the 17th season for our Learning from Ladakh program, which brings people young and old from all
-	parts of the world to live with a Ladakhi farm family during one of two month-long sessions during the agricultural season. This year
-	the participants stayed in Likir a village along the Indus River about 2 hours west of Leh. In addition to the family stays, there were
-	workshops in Leh during each session that help participants see their learning experience from a more global perspective. In
-	addition to the Learning from Ladakh program, we also ran a tourist education program, informing travellers to the region about the
-	impact of their visit, and how to make it a positive one for the Ladakh's people and environment. Daily screenings of Ancient Futures
_	and The Economics of Happiness, followed by discussions led by ISEC staff, reached many hundreds of tourists in 2011.
