At a meeting held on May 19, 2011, the Board of Directors of the corporation adopted a resolution approving the amendments to the Articles of Incorporation as set forth above, and directing that the question be submitted to a vote at a meeting of the members of the Corporation. A quorum was present at the meeting and a majority of the Directors adopted the resolution.
- 4. The amendments were adopted by the members of the corporation at a meeting of the members of the corporation held on May 19, 2011. A quorum was present at the meeting and 2/3 of the members present at the meeting adopted the amendments.
