ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California

The undersigned certify that:

- 1. They are the **president** and the **treasurer**, respectively of TAUBERT MEMORIAL FOUNDATION, a California corporation.
- 2. Article TWO of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation is amended to read as follows:

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, and/or educational purposes, within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law. Despite any other provision in these articles, the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that do not further the purposes of this corporation, and the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law, or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Internal Revenue Code section 170(c)(2) or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law.

The specific purpose of this corporation is to promote education and research in the areas of disease prevention and complementary and alternative medical treatments and healing modalities for all persons in the general public, especially for those with limited resources or who, for other reasons, have been unable to alleviate their health concerns. One means of furthering this purpose is to set up a multi-media library/community center where individuals can learn complementary approaches to address their personal health challenges and ways to optimize health and prevent disease through use of materials available and through classes and workshops held at the center.

- 3. The foregoing amendment of Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the board of directors.
- 4. The corporation has no members.
