Spouses of board members are also invited to attend one or two board meetings each year to provide input and insight on the Center's programs and operations. The president of the Center is required to live in housing on the Center's property. This arrangement is required as a condition of employment and is provided for the convenience of the employer. The value of this housing is \$35,400 and is included on Schedule J, Part II, Column D. The Center owns several homes in the surrounding community to ensure that housing is available for key employees. These homes are rented to employees for fair market rent. Rents are set based on rental rates of comparable housing in the surrounding community. The amount of rent for these homes in 2011 was \$104,458.
