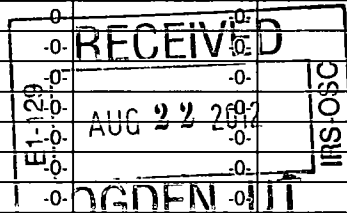

**BY-LAWS**  
**OF**  
**BELLE VIEW EDUCATIONAL AWARDS, INC.**

**ARTICLE ONE: Organization**

The name of this Organization shall be BELLE VIEW EDUCATIONAL AWARDS, INC. It is intended that the Organization be a not-for-profit corporation under New York law that subsequently gains Internal Revenue Service recognition under section 501(c)(3).

**ARTICLE TWO: Purposes**

The Organization, which shall not be conducted for profit, has been formed for the following purposes to which its funds and resources shall be directed:

- To financially assist students who attend college in New York State, especially those whose schedules are limited by part-time jobs, in order to overcome their barriers to participating in extracurricular activities.
- To provide goods in kind such as professional equipment, communication services, and other dedicated educational facilities to students or student groups.
- To obtain 501(c)(3) status with the Internal Revenue Service and subsequently solicit tax-deductible gifts to the Corporation's fund through personal appeals of the Corporation's Board of Directors. Specifically, to collect money from adult persons believed to be supportive of allowing students, especially those with financial constraints, the maximum benefit of their college years

In addition to the above primary purposes aiding students, the Organization may occasionally make awards legal for its status that support other persons or organizations similarly aiding students.

**ARTICLE THREE: Board of Directors**

The business of the organization shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of at least three (3) and no more than seven (7) members. At least one of the Directors shall be a citizen of the United States. ~~Three (3)~~ Two (2) members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum. Each member shall have one (1) vote, and such voting may not be done by proxy. Voting of Directors by personal participation through telecommunications is

permissible. The Board of Directors may make other rules and regulations covering its meetings and procedures as it deems appropriate.

The initial organizing Directors shall have terms of two (2) years. They may be re-elected to further two-year terms by majority vote of the existing board. Additional Directors may be elected to two-year terms by vote of the board and shall, when seated, have equal rights with other board members

The Directors shall elect a Chairman by a majority vote, who shall serve in that capacity for one (1) year. The Chairman shall appoint Directors to the offices of Vice-Chairman and Secretary-Treasurer to serve during his term. The Vice-Chairman may substitute for the Chairman in conducting meetings. The Secretary-Treasurer shall maintain minutes and other records and shall maintain bank accounts through which all funds of the Organization must pass as deposits made and checks emitted.

The Chairman of the Board of Directors shall have the authority to appoint more members to the Board for a period not exceeding one (1) year to fill any vacancies, but the Board shall not consist of more than seven (7) members. Such appointed Directors may be elected to two-year terms by the Board of Directors at any time during their appointed year of service.

Three (3) alternate members may be appointed to the Board of Directors. An alternate member does not have a vote unless he is needed for a quorum as determined by the Chairman.

#### **ARTICLE FOUR: Meetings**

The annual meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held in either the month of April or the month of May, but the Board of Directors may fix a different date, providing only that the different date result in a meeting at least once in every calendar year.

#### **ARTICLE FIVE: Order of Business**

The general order of business for meetings shall be:

- 1 Call to order
- 2 Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting
- 3 Reports of Officers

- 4 Reports of Committees
- 5 Old and unfinished business
- 6 New business
- 7 Adjournment

#### **ARTICLE SIX: Remuneration**

The board of Directors and any officers shall serve without remuneration for time or minor expenses. Consultants or experts may be retained occasionally for appropriate fees by resolution of the board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE SEVEN: Committees**

All committees of the organization shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Directors and shall serve at his pleasure

The Chairman shall appoint an Awards Committee of at least three persons who may be Directors or other persons the Chairman believes to have knowledge and skill to fulfill the purposes of the Corporation when it makes awards to students. The Directors shall constitute no more than 50% of the Awards Committee. Members of the Awards Committee shall recuse themselves, or be recused by a majority vote of the Awards Committee, from any participation in the selection of awardees who may have relationships with such committee members appearing to risk favoritism.

The Awards Committee shall assist the Secretary-Treasurer in the periodic preparation of Schedule H of IRS Forms 1023/990 by maintaining thorough records of the objective basis of awards made.

#### **ARTICLE EIGHT: Dissolution**

Should for any reason the organization be dissolved, its net assets in property, cash, securities, or proceeds of any sale thereof shall become the property of the Zeta Psi Educational Foundation, Pearl River, New York, a federally tax-exempt public educational foundation chartered by the State of New York, to be used for educational leadership purposes similar to those of Belle View Educational Awards, Inc.

**ARTICLE NINE: Amendments**

These by-laws may be altered, amended, repealed, or added to by an affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the Board of Directors present and voting at a regular or special meeting provided that the substance of the intended changes was sent in writing by the proponents to all Directors at least thirty (30) days in advance of said meeting.
