If the grant is above \$10,000, half of the funds are released after the Rally Post-Award Agreement is signed by the grantee. The second half of the funds are released after a Rally Foundation has a competitive peer review process for Letters of Intent (LOIs) and full grant applications, utilizing Proposal Central. LOIs are scored by one reviewer, two if

mid-year report is received by Rally and the research is showing viable progress. Rally requires an end of the year report, or the grantee may apply for an additional year of funding.
