The committee then meets in person with the CEO to discuss and plan for the new year.

The review presented to the CEO is a composite of feedback and comments but the entire committee meets with the CEO for discussion of accomplishments and areas of improvement.

Reasonable compensation within the parameters of the approved budget guidelines will be determined by the committee.

Should the committee determine that compensation adjustments outside the parameters of the approved budget are to be considered, the recommendation must go back to the Board of Directors for approval.

Periodic regional, state, and local Salary and Benefit Studies are undertaken to insure fair and reasonable compensation.

CEO receives salary and reasonable employee benefits.

CEO does not receive a company automobile or monthly automobile allowance, bonus, expense account, or social club memberships as part of compensation.
