Wood River Land Trust Program Achievements 4/1/2011 - 3/31/2012

River Health and Restoration:

The final phase of the Croy Creek Wetlands and Boardwalk was completed in October of 2011. The construction of a 550 foot boardwalk along the wetlands area along with an log pavilion at its entrance were constructed. Interpretive signage was installed which depicts the area's flora and fauna and explains the delicate balance of the wetlands ecosystem. Visitors now enjoy an up-close wildlife experience with minimal impact to the wetland habitat. The Land Trust seeks to balance the public benefits of experiencing nature with the benefits of healthy riparian and wildlife habitat. The wetlands area has already become an outdoor classroom for Wood River Valley students.

We began our Fourth year of Trout Friendly Lawn program, an educational and proactive program addressing how local yard care impacts the health of the Big Wood River and its fishery. Educational sessions for property owners showcased the benefits of using organic non-toxic applications, native plants, and efficient low-impact watering systems and practices to conserve water. Home and business owners were encouraged to conduct a watering audit of their yard by a trained professional in order to find ways to conserve water. Yards that meet certain water conservation and protection requirements are certified as Trout Friendly. Local businesses and other nonprofits partner with the Land Trust. Over 50 lawns and businesses were certified. The program is ongoing.

Project development and outreach for Hulen Meadows Pond project. The project's goal is riparian and river area restoration and improvement of public recreational opportunities. In 2010 surveying and floodplain analysis was conducted and we completed the study for the hydrological and restoration work, flood plain analysis, project analysis, mapping, topographic assessments, initial consultant reviews, approval by the City of Ketchum and legal consultation for stream restoration, flood plain analysis and project analysis which needed to be completed prior to the on-the-ground implementation of any restoration work. This preliminary work was completed in February 2010. Presently the BLM has reviewed the city of Ketchum's application and a master plan has been developed for a Recreation and Public Purposes lease on the 205 acres on the local and regional levels.

The Wood River Land Trust continued its work to reestablish enhanced year-round stream flow in the Big Wood river channel below Magic Reservoir dam. The project's work has primarily consisted of the collaboration with the Big Wood Canal company to consider the release of water year-round in order to reestablish the fishery and riparian area as close to its historical condition as is possible. Outside of the spring/summer irrigation season, no water is released from the dam and the river becomes a trickle as it is comprised solely of water from various low flow springs. In autumn and winter, shutting off the water can result in a substantial fish kill when stranded fish die from lack of oxygen or water. This manipulated and inconsistent stream flow also disrupts wildlife and normal plant life cycles.

We continued our riverbank restoration work and planning in Lion's Park located near the Croy Creek Wetland and Draper Preserve. This area was once a city dump and the Wood River Land Trust in cooperation with local government entities and the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality removed 1,200 tons of dump material in 2008. As

part of our ongoing Big Wood River Greenway project we began the construction of a wooden pedestrian bridge that will link both sides of the Draper preserve spanning across the Big Wood River. This will allow visitors to enjoy approximately two miles of continuous trails along the Big Wood River. The bridge will be completed in the fall of 2012.

Staff organized volunteer work days at riparian/floodplain areas at Boxcar Bend, Howard Preserve, Croy Creek Wetland and Draper Wood River preserves on the Big Wood River, with emphasis on control of noxious weeds.

Land Stewardship:

Staff monitored all thirty-seven (37) Wood River Land Trust conservation easements encompassing 10,175.59 acres to ensure compliance with individual easement restrictions/language and to note any changes in the property. All monitoring data, such as photo points, were reported and entered into the permanent record.

Fee simple lands were also monitored. These Land Trust preserves are maintained in their natural state and/or restored to a healthy landscape. Stewardship staff addresses such ongoing problems as noxious weeds, trash, vehicle incursions, and damaged trails. On the Church Farm property we completed the construction of a cattle fence around the artesian springs and riparian area to avoid riparian damage by grazing cattle. A cattle gap was placed in one area of Willow Creek allowing cattle to water only in this small area and preserving the conservation values and wildlife habitat of the property.

Land Acquisition/Protection:

In August the Wood River Land Trust sold the Timbered Dome property to a conservation-minded rancher. We then subsequently helped this rancher apply for a Grasslands Reserve Program easement which resulted in the property becoming the #1 rated property in the region to be permanently protected under the Grasslands Reserve Program. The Grassland Reserve Program (GRP) is a voluntary conservation program that emphasizes support for working grazing operations, enhancement of plant and animal biodiversity, and protection of grassland under threat of conversion to other uses. Participants voluntarily limit future development and cropping uses of the land while retaining the right to conduct common grazing practices and operations related to the production of forage and seeding, subject to certain restrictions during nesting seasons of Greater Sage-Grouse that are in significant decline or are proposed for protection under Federal or State law. A grazing management plan is required for participants. Sagebrush and grasses are the predominant vegetation on the 1,609-acre property. The ranch is bordered by BLM and private lands and is a critical migratory corridor for elk, deer and antelope and recently had a wintering herd of approximately 250 elk and 500 mule deer. Timbered Dome provides year-round habitat for elk, chukar, raptors, pygmy rabbit, mule deer, and migratory songbirds. Most important are the resident Sage Grouse and their leks on and near the property which needed added protection.

Through our staff's collaborative work with the Pioneer's Alliance we were able to aid other ranchers and property owners to qualify to protect their properties under the Grasslands Reserve Program.
