BY LAWS OF

JACKSON EMC FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE 1. NAME AND OFFICES

SECTION 1. <u>Name</u>. The name of this Corporation shall be JACKSON EMC FOUNDATION, INC., (the "FOUNDATION")

SECTION 2. Registered Office and Agent. The FOUNDATION shall maintain a registered office in the State of Georgia, and shall have a registered office whose address is identical with the address of such registered agent, in accordance with the requirements of the Georgia Nonprofit Corporation Code.

ARTICLE 2. PURPOSE OF ORGANIZATION

The purpose of the FOUNDATION shall be the accumulation and disbursement of funds for charitable purposes in the 10 counties served by Jackson Electric Membership Corporation ("Jackson EMC"). Upon dissolution of the FOUNDATION, any remaining funds shall be distributed only for charitable purposes.

ARTICLE 3. FUNDING

The FOUNDATION shall be funded by such rules and regulations as may be promulgated by the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC Sources of funding may include, but are not limited to, member contributions through Operation Round Up, Jackson EMC employee donations and the assignment of unclaimed capital credits.

ARTICLE 4. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The FOUNDATION shall be administered by not less than (9) nor more than (11) Board of directors (Board). The initial Board shall be designated by the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC. The FOUNDATION shall have at least one (1) Director from each county or group of counties that a Jackson EMC Director represents.

At the initial organizational meeting of the Board of Directors of the FOUNDATION the board shall by lot draw for terms of office of one (1), two (2), and three (3) years. There shall be three (3) Directors chosen to initially serve one (1) year terms; four (4) Directors chosen to initially serve two (2) year terms; and four (4) Directors chosen to initially serve three (3) year terms. Thereafter, the terms of office for each Director shall be for a period of three (3) years.

ARTICLE 5. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERSHIP

A Director of the FOUNDATION shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age, with his primary residence in the county from which he is chosen and be of good moral character. It shall not be necessary for Directors of the FOUNDATION to be members of Jackson EMC. No person seeking or holding a seat on the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC, nor any Jackson EMC employee, shall be a member of the FOUNDATION Board.

ARTICLE 6. SELECTION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The initial Foundation Board shall be appointed by the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC. Thereafter, when vacancies are to be filled or when terms expire, persons shall be appointed to the respective vacancies on the said Board by a vote of the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC. The existing FOUNDATION Board may make recommendations to the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC for nominees for the FOUNDATION Board.

ARTICLE 7. COMPENSATION OF DIRECTORS

No Director shall receive compensation from the FOUNDATION for serving on the FOUNDATION Board.

ARTICLE 8. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

SECTION 1. <u>Regular Meetings</u>. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors of the FOUNDATION shall be held not less than quarterly at a placed designated by the Board, and when meeting, and shall be governed by Robert Rules of Order. The Board of Directors may meet at such other times as they may deem, at their discretion, to be necessary.

SECTION 2 <u>Special Meetings</u> Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by the Chairman or any three (3) Directors, and it shall thereupon be the duty of the Secretary to cause a Notice of such meeting to be given as hereafter provided. The person or persons authorized to call special meetings of the Board of Directors may fix the place and time for holding any special meeting called by them.

SECTION 3 Notice of Directors Meeting. The Secretary shall give notice of any regular meeting at least five (5) days prior to the meeting by e-mail, personal delivery, facsimile or mail. The five-day written notice is not applicable in the event directors receive notice via e-mail, personal delivery, facsimile or mail prior to such special meeting in emergency situations or when time is of the essence.

SECTION 4. Participation in Meeting Through Any Means of Communication.

Directors may participate in meetings of the Board of Directors, through the use of any means of communications by which all directors participating may simultaneously hear each other during the meeting and participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at such a meeting.

SECTION 5. <u>Committees</u>. The Board of Directors may, by resolution passed by a majority of the entire Board, designate one or more committees to consist of three or more of the directors of the FOUNDATION, which, to the extent provided in the resolution, shall perform their duties and report to the Board of Directors. Such committee or committees shall have such names as may be determined from time to time by resolution adopted by the Board.

ARTICLE 9. QUORUM

A majority of the Board of Directors shall, unless otherwise designated, constitute a quorum. In the event that less than a majority of the Board of Directors present may adjourn the meeting and designate a place and time for the next meeting, under which circumstances the Secretary shall notify the absent members of the place and time of the next meeting. An act of the majority of the Board present at any meeting at which a quorum is present, and unless otherwise provided in these Bylaws, shall be the act of the FOUNDATION Board.

ARTICLE 10. REMOVAL OF MEMBER OF BOARD

Any FOUNDATION Director shall automatically cease to be a Board Member if and in the event such Director misses three (3) successive "regular" meetings or attends less than 50% (fifty percent) of the regular meetings beginning September 1st and ending August 31st each year or should a Director leave the county in which he/she resides or represents.

Any FOUNDATION Director may otherwise be removed by the Jackson EMC Board upon recommendation of the FOUNDATION Board.

ARTICLE 11. OFFICERS OF THE CORPORATION

The officers of the FOUNDATION shall be a Chairman, a Vice Chairman, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and such other officers as may be determined by the Board from time to time

ARTICLE 12. ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND TERMS OF OFFICE

Officers shall be elected by the Board annually, by secret ballot.

The terms of office shall be for one (1) one year, however, nothing shall prevent an officer from being re-elected to a maximum of three consecutive terms.

ARTICLE 13. EX OFFICIO MEMBERS OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The President/CEO of Jackson EMC or his designee shall be an ex officio member of the Board of Directors of the FOUNDATION. The FOUNDATION may from time to time have other such ex officio members as the Board may in its discretion determine as necessary or prudent.

The President/CEO of Jackson EMC in his/her capacity as ex officio member of the Board of Directors of the FOUNDATION shall upon request provide assistance to the Secretary and Treasurer of the Board with their official duties hereinafter shown in Article XIII.

ARTICLE 14. POLICIES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS

The Board of Directors of Jackson EMC shall have the power to make and adopt such rules and regulations, not inconsistent with law, the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws, as it may deem advisable for the management, administration and regulation of the business and affairs of the FOUNDATION.

ARTICLE 15. DUTIES OF OFFICERS

- A. CHAIRMAN: The Chairman shall be the principal executive officer of the FOUNDATION and, unless otherwise determined by the Board, shall preside at all meetings of the Board and in general perform all duties incidental to the office of Chairman and such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board from time to time.
- B. VICE CHAIRMAN: In the absence of the Chairman, or in the event of his/her inability or refusal to act, the Vice Chairman shall perform the duties of the Chairman, and when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the Chairman. The Vice Chairman shall also perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him/her by the Board.
- C. **SECRETARY:** The Secretary shall be responsible for the keeping of the minutes of the meetings of the Board in one or more books provided for that purpose; be responsible for seeing that all notices are duly given in accordance with these Bylaws or as required by law; be custodian of the corporate records and of the seal of the

FOUNDATION and affix the seal of the FOUNDATION to all necessary documents, the execution of which on behalf of the FOUNDATION under its seal is duly authorized in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws; have general charge of the books of the FOUNDATION; be responsible for the keeping on file at all times a complete copy of the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the FOUNDATION containing all amendments thereto; and, in general, perform all duties incidental to the office of the Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him/her by the Board.

D. TREASURER: The Treasurer shall have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds and securities of the FOUNDATION; be responsible for the receipt of and the issuance of receipt for monies due and payable to the FOUNDATION from any source whatsoever, and for the deposit of all such monies in the name of the FOUNDATION in such bank or banks as shall be selected in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws; and, in general, perform all the duties incidental to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him/her by the Board.

ARTICLE 16. CHECK SIGNING

Any and all checks issued by the FOUNDATION, and any and all withdrawals by the FOUNDATION, for any purpose, shall be authorized by the Board and shall be signed by two (2) officers or one (1) officer and such other person(s) as may be designated by the Board as having check-signing authority, however, under no circumstances shall checks be signed only by one (1) person.

ARTICLE 17. DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS

Except as otherwise provided by these Bylaws, the Board of Directors of the FOUNDATION shall have the full and sole responsibility for the disbursement of all monies of the FOUNDATION in accordance with the Bylaws and the policies adopted by the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC.

Prior to consideration by the FOUNDATION Board of any disbursement, FOUNDATION Directors shall disclose and explain any personal and/or business interest, connection, kinship or other association he or she has with the person, family, group, corporation or other entity under consideration for funding by the FOUNDATION. Such interested Director shall excuse himself or herself from the meeting, and shall not participate in the discussion of or voting on the disbursement.

Members of the Board of Directors of the FOUNDATION, immediate family members of the members of the Board of Directors of the FOUNDATION, members of the Board of Directors of Jackson Electric Membership Corporation, immediate family members of the members of the Board of Directors of Jackson Electric Membership Corporation, employees of Jackson Electric Membership Corporation and immediate family members of employees of Jackson Electric Membership Corporation shall not be

eligible to receive any disbursement of monies from the FOUNDATION. For the purposes of this Article XVII, immediate family members means spouse, parent, son, daughter, brother, sister, niece, nephew, half-sibling, step-sibling, grandparent, grandchild, in-laws and step-parents.

No disbursements of monies from the FOUNDATION shall be used for the direct payment of electric or gas bills; however, the FOUNDATION may make donations to agencies such as Project Share of the Salvation Army whose purpose is to assist with utility bill payments.

ARTICLE 18. TRANSFER OF FUNDS

Jackson EMC shall transfer funds collected by it for the benefit of the FOUNDATION on a regular basis, but in no event less than quarterly. The FOUNDATION may also solicit and accept contributions from other sources as deemed appropriate by its Board of Directors.

ARTICLE 19. INVESTMENT OF FUNDS

The FOUNDATION Board shall be responsible for the funds entrusted to it and shall make such investment of said funds in a manner which is reasonable and prudent and in keeping with these Bylaws and the policies of the FOUNDATION.

ARTICLE 20. ACCOUNTING SYSTEM AND REPORTS

The FOUNDATION Board shall cause to be established and maintained a complete accounting system that is in keeping with sound financial management, and furthermore the FOUNDATION Board shall make reports to the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC on the operation and expenditures of the FOUNDATION as may be necessary and prudent, but in no case less than annually.

ARTICLE 21. POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS

No funds of the FOUNDATION shall be used in any fashion to support any candidate for political office or for any political purpose.

ARTICLE 22. BORROWING FUNDS

The FOUNDATION shall NOT have the authority to borrow monies nor incur debt from any bank, savings and loan or other institutions for such purpose.

ARTICLE 23. RETENTION OF FUNDS

To assure that the FOUNDATION maintains a reasonable level of funds for its operation, the FOUNDATION shall accumulate and maintain a reserve fund of not less TEN THOUSAND AND NO/100THS (\$10,000.00).

ARTICLE 24. PROXY VOTING

There shall not exist proxy voting at any meeting of the FOUNDATION Board.

ARTICLE 25. AUDIT

The FOUNDATION Board shall on an annual basis cause the books and records of the FOUNDATION to be audited by a certified public accountant and a report in keeping with sound accounting principles be issued to the FOUNDATION Board and the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC.

ARTICLE 26. FISCAL YEAR

The Fiscal Year of the FOUNDATION shall commence on the 1st day of June of each calendar year and end on the 31st day of May of each calendar year.

ARTICLE 27. INDEMNIFICATION

SECTION 1. Right of Indemnification. Subject to the provisions of Section 2 of this Article, the FOUNDATION, shall indemnify any person who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative (other than an action by or in the right of the FOUNDATION in which such person was adjudged liable to the FOUNDATION or in any other proceeding in which such person was adjudged liable on the basis that personal benefit was improperly received by such person) by reason of the fact that he is or was a director, officer, employee or agent of the FOUNDATION against expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by him in connection with such action, suit or proceeding, if he acted in a manner he believed in good faith to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the FOUNDATION, and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe his conduct was unlawful. The termination of any action, suit or proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, conviction, or upon a plea of nolo contendere or its equivalent, shall not, of itself, be determinative that the person did not act in a manner which he believed in good faith to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the FOUNDATION, and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe that his conduct was unlawful.

SECTION 2. <u>Determination and Authorization of Indemnification</u>. Any indemnification under Section 1 of this Article (unless ordered by a court) shall be made by the FOUNDATION only as authorized in the specific case upon a determination that indemnification of the director, officer, employee or agent is proper in the circumstances because he had met the applicable standard of conduct set forth in said Section 1. Such determination shall be made (a) by the Board of Directors, by a majority vote of a quorum consisting of directors who were not parties to such action, suit or proceeding; (b) if such quorum is not obtainable, by a majority vote of a committee duly designated by the Board of Directors (in which designation directors who are parties may participate), consisting solely of two or more directors not at the time parties to the proceeding; (c) by special legal counsel selected by the Board of Directors or its committee in the manner prescribed in (a) or (b) above; or if a quorum cannot be obtained or under (a) above and a committee cannot be selected under (b), by majority vote of the full Board of Directors (in which selection directors who are parties may participate; or (d) by the members who are not parties to the proceeding).

SECTION 3. <u>Mandatory indemnification</u>. If a director, officer, employee or agent of the FOUNDATION has been successful on the merits or otherwise as a party to any action, suit or proceeding, referred to in Section 1 of the Article, or with respect to any claim, issue or matter therein (to the extent that a portion of his expenses can be reasonably allocated thereto), he shall be indemnified against expenses (including attorney's fees) actually and reasonably incurred by him in connection therewith.

SECTION 4. Advance for Expenses. Reasonable expenses incurred in connection with a civil, criminal, administrative or investigative action, suit or proceeding, or threat thereof, may be paid by the FOUNDATION in advance of the final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding as authorized by the Board of Directors in the specific case upon receipt of a written affirmation of such person of his good faith belief that such person has acted in a manner which he believed good faith to be in or not opposed to the best interest of the FOUNDATION, and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding had no reasonable cause to believe that his conduct was unlawful and an undertaking by or on behalf of the director, officer, employee or agent to repay such amount unless it shall ultimately be determined that he is entitled to be indemnified by the FOUNDATION as authorized in this Article.

SECTION 5. <u>Insurance</u> By action of the Board of Directors, notwithstanding any interest of the directors in the action, to the full extent permitted by applicable law, the FOUNDATION may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a director, officer, employee or agent of the FOUNDATION, against any liability asserted against him and incurred by him in any such capacity, or arising out of his status as such, whether or not the FOUNDATION would have the power to indemnify him against such liability under the provisions of the Article or of Section 14-12-851 or Section 14-2-852 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

SECTION 6. Non-exclusivity. The provisions for indemnification and advancement of expenses provided by this Article shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights, in respect of indemnification or otherwise, to which those seeking indemnification may be entitled under any bylaw, agreement, either specifically or in general terms, resolution, or approved by the affirmative vote of the members entitled to vote thereon taken at a meeting, the notice of which specified that such bylaw, resolution or agreement would be placed before the members, both as to action by a director, officer, employee or agent in his official capacity and as to action in another capacity while holding such office or position, except that no such other rights, in respect to indemnification or otherwise, may be provided or granted with respect to the liability of any director, officer, employee or agent for (a) any appropriation, in violation of his duties, of any business opportunity of the FOUNDATION; (b) acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law; (c) liabilities of a director imposed by Section 14-2-832 of the Georgia Business Corporation Code; or (d) any transaction from which the director, officer, employee, or agent derived an improper personal benefit.

ARTICLE 28. AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed and new Bylaws may be adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the entire Board of Directors of Jackson Electric Membership Corporation. The FOUNDATION Board may make advisory recommendations concerning the alteration, amendment or repeal of the Bylaws and the adoption of new Bylaws to the Board of Directors of Jackson EMC.
