EXHIBIT A TO RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF The Opportunity Alliance

FIRST: The Name of the Corporation is The Opportunity Alliance, formerly known as Peoples Regional Opportunity Program (PROP)

SECOND: This Corporation is organized and shall be operated as a public benefit corporation within the meaning of Section 1406 of the Maine Nonprofit Corporation Act, Title 13-B of the Maine Revised Statutes (The "Act"), exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended, and the regulations thereunder, or successor provisions of any future federal tax law (the "Code"). In furtherance thereof, but not by way of limitation, the mission of the Corporation is to assist those in need and in poverty through the development and administration of programs which: address the causes and conditions of poverty; enhance educational and employment opportunities; improve the conditions under which people live, learn and work; encourage and strengthen family relationships; provide support to people in crisis; focus on prevention in all initiatives; and provide leadership in policy development and advocacy.

The Corporation shall be organized and empowered to do everything necessary, proper, advisable or convenient for the accomplishment of the foregoing purposes, and to do all other things incidental to them, or connected with them, that are not forbidden by law, these Articles of Incorporation, or the Corporation's Bylaws; provided, however, that the Corporation shall not engage in any transaction, or do or permit any act or omission, which shall operate to deprive the Corporation of status as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and to which contributions are deductible under Sections 170(c)(2), and 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2) of the Code.

THIRD: As of the filing of these Articles with the Secretary of State of the State of Maine, the Registered Agent is a Noncommercial Registered Agent:

The Registered Agent and Registered Office of the Corporation may be changed at any time in accordance with the provisions of the Act

FOURTH: Pursuant to 5 M.R.S.A § 108 3, the registered agent as listed above has consented to serve as the registered agent for this nonprofit corporation.

FIFTH: The minimum number of Directors (not less than three (3)) shall be fifteen (15) and the maximum number of Directors shall be thirty (30), the qualification and selection of which shall be provided for in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

SIXTH: There shall be no members as such term is used in the Act.

SEVENTH: No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation except as may be permitted under Section 501(h) of the Code. Furthermore, the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

EIGHTH: Other provisions of these articles, including provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation on and requirements of the Internal Revenue Code section 501(c), are as follows:

- A. <u>No Inurement.</u> No Director, Officer, employee, or any other private individual shall be entitled to receive directly or indirectly any pecuniary profit from the operation of this Corporation and all of the assets and income of the corporation shall be used exclusively for its charitable, scientific, or educational purposes. No part thereof shall inure to the benefit of any Director, Officer, employee, or other private individual; provided, however, that nothing contained herein shall be construed to prevent payment by the Corporation of salaries and expenses to Officers and employees of the Corporation employed by it.
- B. <u>Dissolution, Distribution of Assets.</u> If this Corporation be dissolved or its legal existence terminated, either voluntarily or involuntarily, or upon final liquidation of this Corporation, none of its assets shall inure to the benefit of any member, Director, Officer, employee, or any private individual, and all of its assets remaining after payment of all of its habilities shall be distributed to one or more nonprofit organizations engaged in activities substantially similar to those of this Corporation (within the meaning of Section 407 of the Act) and which may be selected by the Directors as an appropriate recipient of such assets, as long as each of such organizations shall then qualify as an organization exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(a) of the Code, described in Section 501(c)(3) of such Code and classified as a public benefit corporation within the meaning of section 1406 of the Act
- C. <u>Number of Directors</u>. Subject to the limitations set forth in Article FIFTH, the number of Directors of the Corporation may be increased or decreased, by resolution of the Directors, to any number divisible by three (3), provided that no decrease in number shall have the effect of shortening the term of any incumbent Director.
