EDUCATION: Middlesex United Way funds and partners with all 15 towns in Middlesex County and their Early Childhood Councils (ECC), which United Way helped to develop, to increase children's readiness to learn by school entry. With our support the ECC have strengthened communication and coordination between parents, pediatricians, daycare providers, preschool and grade-school educators in identifying and servicing at-risk children, birth to five years of age, to enhance their development in social and emotional domains. This effort has influenced the improvement and consistency of preschool classroom curriculums, instruction, assessments, behavior management techniques and professional training opportunities throughout the county.

On Day of Caring in September, United Way mobilized volunteers, businesses, schools and ECCs to help install Born Learning Trails in nine towns in Middlesex County. Two trails were installed previously. The trails are a set of fun, physical activities for parents and caregivers to do with children that help promote early learning and healthy development. All trails were installed in public locations so that the entire community can benefit.

**INCOME:** Middlesex United Way funds and partners with numerous community health and human service organizations throughout Middlesex County to improve the economic self-sufficiency of individuals and families. We ensure that necessary programs are in place for county residents to provide job and literacy training, provide basic human needs and empower individuals who are disabled.

For the fifth year, Middlesex United Way provides leadership and support to the Middlesex VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) Coalition. VITA sites, including one at United Way, provide free income tax preparation services to low-income families and increase the number of individuals and families accessing available tax credits which they have earned. Volunteers, trained and certified by the IRS, helped prepare the taxes for 349 Middlesex County residents who received a total of \$450,311 in tax refunds. Those who qualified received an average refund of \$1,481.

United Labor Agency, a Middlesex United Way funding partner, provides Employment Counseling and livelihood related counseling to individuals who would otherwise not be eligible to receive services elsewhere. Many have disabilities or barriers to employment that do not qualify-them for-services. Of the individuals-served, 100% reported improved job seeking skills, 69% reported receiving job interviews, and 57% reported obtaining employment.

Middlesex United Way also partners with the FamilyWize Prescription Drug Discount program to help individuals and families reduce the cost of prescription medicine. The card is free and available to anyone. Middlesex County residents have saved nearly \$200,000 on their prescriptions.

HEALTH: Middlesex United Way continues to support the Healthy Communities-Healthy Youth (HCHY) substance abuse prevention initiative in 13 towns throughout Middlesex County to help reduce the rate of risky behaviors among youth. HCHY brings together youth and family service providers, schools, town officials, concerned parents and students around a single, coordinated effort utilizing the Search Institute's Profiles of Student Life: Attitudes and Behaviors to 40 Developmental Assets. The 40 Developmental Assets (e.g. Parent Involvement, Family Boundaries, Adult Role Models) are evidence-based, positive experiences and qualities that help influence choices young people make, and helps to influence the type of adult they will become. In the 13 towns that have been surveyed at least twice through HCHY, youth reporting substance abuse decreased 25%, violence decreased 24%, and anti-social behavior decreased 11%.

Middlesex United Way has provided funding and partnered with numerous community health and human service organizations throughout Middlesex County to help improve the health and increase the safety of individuals and families. We ensure that services are available in times of need or crisis for an individual or at the community level including mental health services, disaster relief, counseling, substance abuse treatment, and personal safety.

**HOUSING:** Middlesex United Way has provided funding and leadership in the implementation of the Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness by bringing together community leaders, housing advocates, service providers and other concerned residents from throughout Middlesex County.

Prevention is a key strategy of the Ten Year Plan and therefore, the Homeless Prevention Fund helps individuals and families who are at-risk of homelessness. More than 200 households have been able to remain in their homes thanks to the one-time assistance from the Prevention Fund, preventing them from becoming homeless. Grants are used to pay for rent, utilities, car repairs and other needs while waiting for unemployment to begin, new job wages to start, or other benefits to be provided. The number of households includes more than 250 children.

HOPE Partnership in Old Saybrook completed work on a 16-unit affordable housing development on Ferry Point Road. Four of the new units are for formerly homeless families and two are for homeless Veterans.

WOMEN'S INITIATIVE: The Middlesex United Way Women's Initiative (WI) works to energize and inspire women to make a difference through education, advocacy and leadership. Through fundraising efforts, the WI distributes small, one-time grants to nonprofit programs that meet one or more of the WI's focus areas: early childhood development, empowering young women, and financial stability. One recent grant was provided to the Girl Scouts of Connecticut to help establish a Girlz-R-U-L-E- program-at-Woodrow-Wilson Middle School. The programaims to build confidence and self-esteem in young women while reducing bullying among girls.

The WI hosts a bi-monthly women's networking breakfast at Water's Edge Center for Health and Rehabilitation featuring guest speakers on a variety of informative topics of interest to women. The group hosted its second free financial literacy workshop at Middlesex Community College called *Understanding Your Credit Report*. In conjunction with its annual fundraiser, *Power of the Purse*, the WI collected toiletries and "gently used" purses. Nearly 450 purses were

donated and along with the toiletries, distributed to ten programs working with women to help them get back on their feet. The WI also ran a drive to collect more than 500 books that were distributed to early learning programs. The group distributed small, one-time grants to the following programs: Pretty Wings, Hallie House, Community Music School, Ryan Woods Autism Foundation, and Leap into Learning. Several WI volunteers have been trained to facilitate financial literacy workshops by a Money Management International professional. The WI will offer basic financial literacy workshops to programs working with women and teens.

YOUNG LEADERS SOCIETY: The Young Leaders Society (YLS) celebrates and strengthens the power of young professionals to become leaders in our organizations and bring about positive change in our community. The YLS provides community involvement, professional development, and networking for people 40 years of age or younger who live or work in Middlesex County. The group's mission is to create opportunities for young professionals to get involved with United Way, connect with colleagues and community leaders, and give back to advance the common good.

The group's networking events included an inaugural Holiday Social and Stuff-A-Cruiser Toy Drive where 170 toys were collected and donated to local elementary schools at this event. The YLS hosted four successful Learn with Leaders events to provide young professionals an opportunity to connect with local leaders who know the importance of civic engagement. They have also organized volunteer projects for members including preparing homes for restoration through H.O.P.E.'s housing restoration project, collecting nonperishable food items for the Middletown Community Thanksgiving Project, and participating in a camp cleanup day at Camp Ingersoll.
