Explanation Philanthropy

- The Asian American Community Fund, the Asian American Federation's annual grant-making program, made \$228,500 to 15 grant awards. Since 1993, the Federation has supported critical programs for Asian American individuals and families through its Community Fund, awarded to local community organizations through a competitive application process. example for FY 2011-2012, we awarded a program grant to the Korean American Family Service Center (KAFSC) to launch a new series of workshops on sexual assault and career path decisions for Korean American youth (ages 13-18). The South Asian Council for Social Services received a grant to develop a South Asian Mental Health Support Network that provides culturally and linguistically relevant mental health services to seniors. • For FY 2011-2012, the Federation has expanded its philanthropic programs, working hard to raise needed funds to the community through our Community Fund. Diversifying its fundraising strategies that cater to different donor audiences, we hosted our annual Spirit of Asian America Gala (May 3, 2012), our annual Asian American Golf Classic (June 25, 2012), our Charity Bowl-A-Thon (November 15, 2011) for young corporate professionals, and our first online appeal in collaboration with W. K. Kellogg Foundation's Cultures of Giving Donor Challenge (April 17-24, 2012).
- ·Linking donors, corporate sponsors and foundations to our members has also been an important role for the Federation. We held several networking events including a lunar new year's celebration and a series of Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month events with NBCUniversal, News Corporation and Empire BlueCross BlueShield. We also match volunteers with members; for instance, we coordinated a volunteering day for Bank of America's Asian Leadership Network (ALN) to help paint the children's rooms and stairwells for residents at New York Asian Women's Center's Rose House Shelter.
- . We also worked closely with local foundations to bring resources and support to our members. On November 17, 2011, the Ong Family Foundation, along with the Federation and the Coalition for Asian American Children and Families, sponsored Big Apple Circus tickets for children at local Asian afterschool programs. We also hosted an Asian Foundations & Funders Reception (June 27, 2011) to bring together local Asian family foundations, sharing best philanthropic practices and discussing how to address pressing concerns for our community. Capacity Building
- The Federation strengthens our members' services, management and fundraising abilities by providing trainings, technical assistance and capacity-building grants. For instance, one of our capacity-building grants enabled the Coalition for Asian American Children and Families to develop a strategic plan, train the board on fundraising and clarify the role of youth, parents and its member agencies in advocacy campaigns.
- The Federation organized a workshop for members on January 20, 2012 providing useful tips on how to craft compelling New York City Councilmember discretionary funding requests and how to effectively introduce your organization to city leaders. We also co-hosted a second training with New York City Council's Queens delegation (Councilmembers Leroy Comrie and Peter Koo) on March 3, 2012.
- As a resource for our members and other community organizations, a new edition of our Human Services Directory was released in January 2012 providing a comprehensive booklet of all

Policy & Research

- •The Federation published a report in April 2012, entitled Asian Americans in New York City: A Decade of Dynamic Change 2000-2010, the first detailed look at Asian New Yorkers based on the recent data releases from the 2010 Census and the new American Community Survey. Documenting that the Asian American community in New York was the fastest growing major population in New York City (now nearly 14%), the report covered changes in demographics in the past ten years including poverty, income and civic engagement, and also examined the status of Asian children and seniors as related to education, poverty and health insurance coverage. Its findings were presented at our community briefing on April 20, 2012 where over 70 people came from community organizations, foundations, corporations, academia, government agencies including New York State Attorney General's Office, and press from World Journal and Voice of America.
- We also outreached extensively in the community helping community organizations, government agencies, media, educational institutions, businesses and the general public better understand and utilize the Census data results to identify the needs of the Asian Americans they serve. Our staff conducted community trainings across New York City including Queens Central Library and presentations at the 2011 Advancing Justice Conference and the 25th Annual National Association of Asian American Professionals' Conference.
- The Federation also facilitates collaboration among member and community agencies and forms coalitions to work together in responding to emerging community needs and advocating for the Asian American community. In January 2012, the Federation convened community agencies and civic groups to form the Asian American Civic Alliance to increase voter education and help voters learn more about campaign finance laws. On March 12, 2012, the Alliance in partnership with the New York City Campaign Finance Board coordinated a community workshop on the dos and don'ts of campaign finance.
