Scholarships are awarded to children of current employees of Lockwood, Kessler & Bartlett and of a successor company of the former Continental Can Company, Inc. Maximum scholarship award is \$10,000 per year for four years. In addition, contributions are made to Norwalk Community College Foundation for scholarships to NCC students selected by Norwalk Community College.
