As required in Section 1 170A-9T Section (F) subsection 3(i), USCAN does receive more than 10% of its support from public sources. USCAN is undertaking a campaign for additional financial support, as outlined in Section 1 17A-9T Section (F) subsection 3 (II) In addition to fundraising with traditional foundations that support climate change work, USCAN is approaching new funding sources and continues to raise money from our membership base, which consists primarily of 501(c)3 organizations. Our membership dues, which are paid annually, use a sliding scale so that any interested party has access to the network of USCAN. In an effort to broaden our base of support, our staff and board are working together to retain new funding. USCAN was founded in 1989 and has board members from across the country representing small, large, local and national organizations The organization itself is comprised of 100 non-profit and academic groups who work on climate change issues, and USCAN serves a singularly important role in helping them to coordinate together at the local, regional, national and international level. This work helps keep governing bodies accountable to the public, protects populations that are vulnerable to climate change, and fosters a sense of community for those working on climate change issues.
