 - (a) Government and institutional relations: HANJ was instrumental in leading New Jersey to establish the nation's first Hemophilia program which assists eligible hemophiliacs to obtain clotting factor. The program also supports New Jersey's Comprehensive Hemophilia Care Centers. The HANJ is also cooperating with the state to prevent duplication of health care delivery service. The HANJ is working with New Jersey Blue Cross to expand eligible services to hemophiliacs. We have also negotiated lower prices for clotting factor with pharmaceutical companies. HANJ appears before the State Joint Appropriations Committee on a yearly basis, to ensure subsequent funding.

(b) Patient care: Provides educational and financial assistance to hemophiliacs on homecare, a program whereby the hemophiliac infuses the clotting factor at home. This program reduces crippling and will reduce medical care costs for the hemophiliac in the long run. The association provides orthopedic appliances to patients not covered by insurance. The association also provides financial counseling to families with hemophiliacs in order to help such families better cope with their medical expenses and to seek out social services which help defray the cost of related services. The HANJ supports Patient Treatment Centers throughout the state through the funding of programs at the centers. Each year, children afflicted with hemophilia are sent to special camps for hemophiliacs around the country; all costs are borne by HANJ.

(c) Public Health Education: A special bureau provides programs on hemophilia to bring a better public understanding of the disease. Educational brochures and printed literature are distributed to groups and organizations upon request. The HANJ participates in community health fairs. Brochures describing the causes and effects of hemophilia and the accomplishments and goals of HANJ are distributed to various organizations and referral sources. The HANJ promotes patient education by conducting educational seminars, which disseminate and coordinate information about all facets of hemophilia and participates in information dissemination and presentation at large professional conventions, such as the State Nursing Convention. The HANJ also publishes a quarterly newsletter, which is distributed to the 500 families/individuals that are community members of the association, every New Jersey state legislator, and several other state chapters and organizations.

(d) Professional Health Education: The Hemophilia Association encourages various branches of the medical profession to attend hemophilia-oriented seminars and courses. The Association also contributes funds to help defray costs of such seminars. During the year, the Association also sponsored two Medical Advisory Board meetings and planned a professional curriculum for educating medical personnel on the facts and issues of women with bleeding disorders.

Research and Grants:

The Association's Board of Trustees refers all requests for research and other professional assistance to a Medical Advisory Board for review and recommendations. The Medical Advisory Board, consisting of approximately ten interested New Jersey physicians, will determine whether or not the proposal has merit. The Association's full Board of Trustees will review the opinion of the Medical Advisory Board. The final decision for research funding and other grants lies with the Association's Board of Trustees, who are not bound by the Medical Advisory Board.

Patient Treatment Center:

The Association's Board of Trustees has full responsibility for awards to Patient Treatment Centers. All requests for Patient Treatment Center funding are reviewed to ensure that the programs for which funds are earmarked fit in with the goals and objectives of the Association and are in the best interest of the Treatment Centers' patients.

Direct Patient Aid:

The Association's Board of Trustees refers all requests for direct patient aid to appropriate committees (Patient Services, Financial Counseling, Blood). The Association covers the patient's costs of infusion sets (needles and syringes) only if not covered by insurance requests. All other direct aid is dependent upon need and the magnitude of the request. In all instances, all other financial resources (insurance, social services, etc.) must be exhausted before any assistance will be offered. The full Board of Trustees has the final decision, based on the recommendations from the various committees.

Scholarship Program:

The scholarship program is open to all young adults with hemophilia attending or planning to attend institutes of higher education and/or advanced education (including trade schools) at an undergraduate level. Each year two new scholarships are awarded – one based on financial need, the other upon merit. Applicants must submit a present grade transcript, proof of enrollment at a college and/or trade school, and a brief letter of accomplishments and future plans. We also award up to six renewals each year. A renewal application must include a present grade transcript and Grade Point Average listing. A grade point standing of 2.5 is needed to apply. Each award is \$1,000. A total of up to \$8,000 is given each year by the Walter Hamilton Scholarship Fund.

Camperships:

Are open to all eligible hemophiliacs (membership and age). The program is overseen by the Social Service Department. All other and any unusual requests require the approval of the Association's full Board of Trustees.
