OTHER PROGRAMS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING WOMEN'S NUTRITIONAL SERVICES PROVIDES NUTRITIONAL AND HEALTH SERVICES TO OVER 14,000 WOMAN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN IN AN ELEVEN COUNTY AREA, THE PROGRAM SERVICES INLUDE BREASTFEEDING, PEER COUNSELING, FOOD STAMP SCREENING AND OUTREACH, AND A SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM SPECIAL INITIATIVES PROGRAM TO PROMOTE HEALTHY LIFESTYLES TO AT RISK POPULATIONS AT THREE SITES GENETICS SCREENING, EDUCATION, AND REFERRAL PROGRAM FOR LOWINCOME INDIVIDUALS AT RISK TO DEVELOP OR GIVE BIRTH TO A CHILD WITH A GENETIC CONDITION FAMILY AND ADOLESCENT EDUCATION TO ASSIST ADOLESCENTS IN DEVELOPING HEALTHY DECISION MAKING SKILLS PEER EDUCATION PROGRAM THAT RECRUITS AND TRAINS TEENS TO ENGAGE THEIR PEERS IN PROMOTING HEALTHY LIFESTYLES AND PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY CANCER EDUCATION PROGRAMS WERE PROVIDED THROUGH THE COUNCIL'S INVOLVEMENT WITH THE PENNSYLVANIA CANCER EDUCATION NETWORK, THESE SERVICES INCLUDE EDUCATIONAL SESSIONS ON PROSTATE, SKIN, COLORECTAL, AND OVARIAN CANCERS
