	the Bering Sea Coast and eastward toward the Alaskan Interior.

	Mission - KNOM (a subsidiary of the Catholic Bishop of Northern Alaska) in March 2012. While KNOM's former entity, Alaska Radio
	Mission -KNOM) was financially independent of the Catholic Bishop of Northern Alaska, a.k.a. CBNA, KNOM did not enjoy the
	autonomy afforded by an independent business relationship. The final stages of this separation from CBNA was accomplished in
	March 2012 with the initial step of FCC approval of the broadcast licenses transfer, then completed through the transfer of all assets
	of the subsidiary entity (Alaska Radio Mission - KNOM a.k.a. CBNA) to KNOM Radio Mission Inc.
	The legal expenses for this transfer and separation was borne solely by KNOM Radio Mission, Inc. These costs totalled \$9620 in
	FY 12.

	KNOM produces local news & weather reports. For the majority of our listeners, KNOM is the only source available for vital local
	news & weather information. Additionally, KNOM's production team acts as a clearinghouse for educational material, including
	information on topics like health care, safety, and positive living. Most of KNOM's programming is produced locally - this means
	the final product is tailored to our audience, unique in many ways from any other population in the United States. This includes
	music aired, the variety of which reflects the interests of listeners, including an extremely large library of collected Native/local
	pieces.
	In recognition of service to the region in FY 12, KNOM received much-coveted National Association of Broadcasters' Marconi Award
	& Crystal Award, and the Alaska Broadcasters Association Goldie Award for Service to Community.

	In spring of 2012, KNOM took on two major projects: installation of Dynamic Carrier Control (DCC) to KNOM's transmitter and plans
	to expand the broadcast studios to include digital production equipment. The former was completed in May, 2012 and resulted in a
	3 month pay-back of the funds invested, and now saves KNOM an average of \$101 on electricity each day (\$36,865 annual estimate).
	Much of the cost was borne by KNOM's former entity, Alaska Radio Mission, but some was carried by KNOM Radio Mission. Thus,
	The pay-back was calculated on the combined entities' costs for the project.
	The latter project is expected to take 3 years. In FY 12, \$41,650 in capitalized costs were invested in the the design phase of the
	digital expansion project and \$963 for State Fire Marshall inspection of the related drawings. \$51,650 was raised for this project in
	FY12 by KNOM Radio Mission, Inc. and \$185,547 was received by KNOM Radio Mission, Inc. from donations intended for this
	purpose by Alaska Radio Mission, KNOM's former entity.

It was the intent of the Board of Directors to insure that financials, particularly the valuation of assets and accounting methods for the operations were set on firm ground. Thus, an audit was performed for the corporation for fiscal year 2012. Any changes to this form 990 are the direct result of consultation with professional auditors.
