Board of Governors, the members of which represent different segments of the floriculture
industry-cut flower growers, greenhouse suppliers, importers, and service firms. This body
reviews and approves research projects for funding submitted by universities worldwide.
On a guarterly basis, Hill solicits contributions from former members of Roses Inc.
through direct mail (Note as of June 30, 2010, Roses Inc. ceased office operations.
Former members are being encouraged to make contributions to Hill.). In addition
Hill provides a quarterly newsletter to the industry which includes progress reports
