Examples of tax positions include the tax-exempt status of the Agency, and various positions related to the potential sources of unrelated business taxable income. The tax benefits recognized in the financial statements from such a position are measured based on the largest benefit that has a greater than 50 percent likelihood of being realized upon ultimate settlement. Management has determined that there are no uncertain tax positions during the reporting periods covered by these financial statements. The Agency is generally no longer subject to examination by the Internal Revenue Service for tax years before 2008.
