ADOPTION AND POST-ADOPTION SERVICES THE ORGANIZATION'S ADOPTION PROGRAM INCLUDES THE DOMESTIC INFANT PROGRAM, MINNESOTA'S WAITING CHILDREN PROGRAM, AND INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS IN MORE THAN A DOZEN COUNTRIES. ONE-THIRD OF THE CHILDREN ADOPTED INTERNATIONALLY ARE ADOPTED THROUGH THE ORGANIZATION'S WAITING INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN PROGRAM. THE ORGANIZATION MAINTAINS OFFICES IN THE ST. PAUL-MINNEAPOLIS AND WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREAS TO SERVE FAMILIES IN MINNESOTA, WISCONSIN, MARYLAND, VIRGINIA AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA USING A NETWORK OF PARTNER AGENCIES, THE ORGANIZATION SERVES FAMILIES THROUGHOUT THE U.S. WITH COOPERATIVE ADOPTION. THE ORGANIZATION'S POST-ADOPTION SERVICES WAS THE FIRST OF ITS KIND IN THE U.S., AND PROVIDES DOMESTIC SEARCH AND BACKGROUND SERVICES, INTERNATIONAL SEARCH AND OUTREACH SERVICES, BIRTHLAND TOURS, AND SUPPORT, COUNSELING AND EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE ADOPTIVE CIRCLE.

EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND EDUCATION THE ORGANIZATION OPERATES SIX EARLY LEARNING CENTERS LOCATED IN SCHOOLS, ON COLLEGE AND CORPORATE CAMPUSES, AND A DROP-IN PROGRAM FOR RAMSEY COUNTY. THESE CENTERS OFFER PROFESSIONAL EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND EDUCATION IN AN ENVIRONMENT THAT PROVIDES HIGH QUALITY EARLY LEARNING EXPERIENCES TO PROMOTE KINDERGARTEN READINESS AND FUTURE SUCCESS IN SCHOOL. EMOTIONAL AND SOCIAL HEALTH IS RECOGNIZED AS CRUCIAL TO THE CHILD'S DEVELOPMENT AND SCHOOL READINESS. THEREFORE, A COMPREHENSIVE ARRAY OF SUPPORT SERVICES FOR CHILDREN AND PARENTS IS EASILY ACCESSIBLE AND AVAILABLE. IN MAY 2012, THE ORGANIZATION'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS ADOPTED A REVISED BUSINESS PLAN THAT INCLUDED THE DECISION TO TRANSFER THE EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS TO OTHER AGENCIES. MANAGEMENT HAS IDENTIFIED TWO ENTITIES TO ACCEPT THE TRANSFER, WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO OCCUR ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31, 2013. UNTIL THEN, THE ORGANIZATION WILL CONTINUE TO OPERATE ALL PROGRAMS.

CHILD & FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES PARENT SUPPORT SERVICES ARE VOLUNTARY AND CONFIDENTIAL, PROVIDED AT NO COST TO ELIGIBLE FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN, WITH THE GOAL OF HELPING THEM BUILD THE SKILLS NECESSARY TO SUCCEED IN DAILY LIFE, BUILD SELF-SUFFICIENCY, AND TO PREVENT ABUSE AND NEGLECT. IN ADDITION, SERVICES IN THIS AREA INCLUDE DOMESTIC-ABUSE AND ANGER-MANAGEMENT CLASSES AND GROUPS, AND LEARNING DISABILITIES PROGRAM. THROUGH INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY COUNSELING, THE ORGANIZATION PROVIDES QUALITY THERAPEUTIC SERVICES TO CHILDREN OVER AGE THREE, TEENS, ADULTS AND FAMILIES. THE ORGANIZATION'S LICENSED PROFESSIONALS HELP PEOPLE DEAL WITH PROBLEMS SUCH AS DEPRESSION, ANXIETY, FEAR, TROUBLE WITH FORMING SECURE ATTACHMENTS, RELATIONSHIP DIFFICULTIES, CONFLICT-RESOLUTION STRUGGLES OR POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS. THE ORGANIZATION HAS EXPANDED ITS OFFERINGS OF CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, FOLLOWING THE MERGER WITH FAMILY NETWORKS, INC., INCLUDING SCHOOL-LINKED TREATMENT, DAY TREATMENT, AND CASE MANAGEMENT. IN MAY 2011, THE ORGANIZATION'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS ADOPTED A REVISED BUSINESS PLAN THAT INCLUDED THE DECISION TO TRANSFER THE CHILD & FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS TO ANOTHER AGENCY. MANAGEMENT IDENTIFIED AN ENTITY TO ACCEPT THE TRANSFER, WHICH OCCURRED ON DECEMBER 31, 2011.
