The meals are donated by local area restaurants, hotels, businesses, board members, friends and their families and members of the community who want to make a difference in the lives of those less fortunate than themselves. The weekly meals are served in a warm and welcoming atmosphere by a host of dedicated volunteers who assure a positive experience for the guests. In addition to the hot meals served, we put together 65 bag meals for those who cannot be accommodated in the dining hall because of fire code requirements. A typical CHI meal will include either guest speakers, live entertainment or game nights. Guest speakers provide information about matters of interest to our clients.
