AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ST. VINCENT FOUNDATION

The undersigned Corporation hereby executes these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation pursuant to the Arkansas Nonprofit Corporation Act, 1963 Ark. Acts 176, Arkansas Code Annotated §§ 4-28-201 to -206 and 4-28-209 to -224 (the "Act"). The Articles of Incorporation of the undersigned Corporation are amended and restated to read in their entirety as follows:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the Corporation is St. Vincent Foundation.

ARTICLE II Nonprofit Corporation

The Corporation is a nonprofit, public benefit corporation.

ARTICLE III Purposes and Powers

Section 3.1 The Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in effect or as subsequently amended (the "Code"). No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any private person, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth below. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

Section 3.2 In furtherance of the foregoing, the Corporation shall:

a. foster, support and encourage the activities and purposes of St. Vincent Infirmary Medical Center, d/b/a St. Vincent Health System, an Arkansas nonprofit corporation (the "Corporate Member"), a qualified Exempt Organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code ("Exempt Organization"), and to advance its objectives, including, without limiting the foregoing, the sponsorship of, and assistance to, specific projects and programs to improve the

medical and patient care at the Corporate Member; so long as the Corporate Member exists and qualifies as an Exempt Organization;

- b. receive, manage and administer funds exclusively for the Corporate Member, a qualified Organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, so long as the Corporate Member exists and qualifies as an Exempt Organization;
- c. have all powers and authorities set forth in or contemplated by Act No. 176 of the General Assembly of Arkansas of 1963, as now in effect or as hereafter amended, provided, however, such powers and authorities shall be specifically limited by the purposes expressed in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this Section 3.2; and
- d. do any and all things necessary, convenient, useful or incidental to the attainment of its purposes, as more specifically set forth in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this Section 3.2, as fully and to the same extent as natural persons lawfully might or could do so long as same are consistent with and do not contravene the provisions of Act 176 of 1963.
- Section 3.3 Nothing contained in this Article shall be construed as limiting the powers conferred upon the Corporation by the Act. The Corporation, in order to carry out its purposes, shall have all the powers set out in the Act.

ARTICLE IV <u>Principal Office and Registered Agent</u>

The address of the principal office is Two St. Vincent Circle, Little Rock, Arkansas 72205. The registered agent is The Corporation Company, and the address of the registered agent is 124 West Capitol Avenue, Suite 1400, Little Rock, Arkansas 72201.

ARTICLE V Membership

- Section 5.1 The sole corporate member of the Corporation is St. Vincent Infirmary Medical Center, d/b/a St. Vincent Health System, an Arkansas nonprofit corporation (the "Corporate Member").
- Section 5.2 In addition to the rights and powers granted by the laws of the State of Arkansas, the Corporate Member shall have such rights and powers with respect to the governance of the Corporation as may from time to time be set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI Board of Directors

The Board of Directors shall consist of appointed and ex officio members. Each member of the Board of Directors shall serve for a term of three (3) years. The number, tenure, and qualifications of the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be otherwise determined in accordance with the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII <u>Dissolution</u>

Upon the dissolution or liquidation of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, transfer all of the property and assets of any nature of the Corporation to the Corporate Member, if it is then qualified as an organization exempt from tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and if the Corporate Member is not then so qualified, then to any successor corporation of the Corporate Member which is then so qualified, and if no such successor is so qualified, then to Catholic Health Initiatives, a Colorado nonprofit corporation and the sole corporate member of the Corporate Member ("CHI"), or to CHI's successor, provided CHI or its successor is then so qualified. Any assets not so disposed of in accordance with the above procedures shall be disposed of by the court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation has been located. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Article VI to the contrary, and regardless of the manner in which the assets are distributed, such assets shall in all events remain in and be employed for the benefit of the community served by the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII Amendment

No alteration, amendment, repealer, or restatement of these Articles of Incorporation shall be effective without the approval of the Corporate Member, in accordance with the Bylaws of the Corporation.
