The Saint Agnes Foundation also sponsors the Red Dress Sunday event, a faith-based health education and outreach program designed to raise awareness of the devastating effects of heart disease among women of color. This event began in 2005 with three partnered congregations and has grown to include over one hundred congregations spanning five counties in the state of Maryland. This highly successful event is estimated to have reached in excess of 100,000 people, highlighting the risks involved with the number one killer of African-American women in the United States. Saint Agnes Foundation also provided funding to other organizations, such as My Brother's Keeper, a faith based soup kitchen that provides both nutritional and spiritual nourishment and social services in an effort to break the cycle of poverty and addiction. Furthermore, Saint Agnes Foundation provided scholarships to allow students to obtain a quality education.
