INITIATE PROGRAMS AS A METHOD OF HANDLING CONFLICT AND AS A FORM OF MEDIATION WITHIN THE COMMUNITY IN LIEU OF JUDICIAL EDUCATION, OUTREACH & PROMOTIONS ARE CONDUCTED EACH YEAR AT SCHOOL, NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATIONS, ETC TO INFORM INDIVIDUALS ABOUT COMMUNITY CONFERENCING AS A METHOD OF HANDLING CONFLICTS COMMUNITIES IS A PROGRAM THAT ENABLES BALTIMORE RESIDENTS TO REQUEST A COMMUNITY CONFERENCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF HANDLING NEIGHBORHOOD CONFLICTS THE JUVENILE JUSTICE PROGRAM PROVIDES CONFERENCING SERVICES AS A FORM OF MEDIATION AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION FOR JUVENILE LEGAL CASES THE SCHOOLS PROGRAM ADDRESSES CONFLICTS INVOLVING STUDENTS THAT COULD POTENTIALLY LEAD TO HARM AND DISRUPTION OF THE CLASSROOM ENVIRONMENT
