Batesland Schools LLC will ensure tax credits are not jeopardized during the duration of the compliance period. This program aligns with Grow South Dakota's Tax-Exempt Purpose by creating jobs in an economic distressed area, by fostering educational opportunities, and by promoting overall growth and sustainability for the community. Grow South Dakota formed Pheasant Valley Courtyard, LLC in a previous year; however, activity began during this year. Pheasant Valley Courtyard LLC was formed to obtain a neighborhood stabilization program loan from South Dakota Housing Development Authority to rehabilitate the 60 unit apartment buildings for its housing program. This project aligns with Grow South Dakota's Tax-Exempt Purpose by providing affordable, safe, and energy efficient housing to a small community.
