### Dear Sir or Madam:

In late 2015, the University of South Carolina Educational Foundation (the "Foundation") became aware that cash transfers totaling \$421,751 were made to a foreign corporation which should have been disclosed on Form 926: Transfer of Property to a Foreign Corporation. The attached amended return (Form 990) which includes Form 926, is being filed to report this activity.

The Foundation believes it has reasonable cause that contributed to the Foundation's failure to file Form 926 in a timely manner based upon the following:

As of June 30, 2012, the Foundation had assets of \$340,226,394. Of this amount, \$230,349,753 was invested with approximately 16 different investments managers each handling a wide range of stocks, bonds, etc. Having such a large portfolio, a third party investment advisory firm was retained to assist the Foundation with investment management, to include selection of appropriate investment managers. The Foundation was not aware that one of these investment managers would engage in transactions that would require reporting on Form 926.

The amounts that were required to be disclosed as a transfer to a Foreign Corporation totaled \$421,751. This amount makes up less than a tenth of one percent of the Foundation's total assets. The matter first came to the Foundation's attention when a third party accounting Firm (Elliott Davis Decosimo) was reviewing the Foundation's underlying investments. Upon notification, the Foundation is now taking the needed steps to resolve any and all reporting deficiencies.

In summary, as soon as the requirement to file the Form 926 to disclose a transfer to a foreign corporation came to the Foundation's attention, the Foundation made it a priority to file the Form 926 and correct any deficiencies. The Foundation believes the failure to timely file the Form 926 was due to good faith and reasonable cause and not to willful neglect. The Foundation will make it a priority with all new investments to carefully review the investment activity to ensure that it complies with any and all reporting requirements.
