This includes tracking the funds raised for various projects and ensuring that each project is granted the amounts that donors have specified for their contribution. Grants are provided without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, martial status, or handicap. Additionally, on an annual basis, Wellstar Foundation, Inc. conducts a scholarship process for community applicants interested in pursuing degrees in healthcare related fields. Wellstar Foundation has an endowment fund set aside specifically for this purpose. Applicants for scholarships are reviewed and ranked according to the most deserving as determined by the scholarship committee. The scholarship committee is comprised of administrators, employees, and community volunteers. The committee is composed of 20 individuals who review each application a minimum of three times before selecting those applicants for scholarships. Scholarships are awarded up to \$2,500 and are payable to the school which the applicant attends or plans to attend. Scholarships dollars can be applied toward tuition, fees and books.
