**Mission Statement:** To expose youth to the skills and experiences that teach and encourage business leadership. Youth V.I.B.E. encourages business entrepreneurship and professional development. We engage in multiple projects yearly that assist us in this process. We also tap into existing business organizations such as the South DeKalb Business Association, The DeKalb Chamber of Commerce and Leadership DeKalb.

## **PROGRAM 1: Department of Human Services Afterschool Program**

- **After School program – 120 Participants**

Youth V.I.B.E. hosts a daily Afterschool program from 3:20-6:30 for three local DeKalb County Schools. The emphases are placed on homework, academic and enrichment activities as well as other matters such as personal responsibility or sex education.

- **Annual Business Seminar/Training Sessions – 45 Participants**

Youth V.I.B.E. provides high school students with free skills training and the life-long tools needed to be successful in the workplace. The term of the Youth V.I.B.E. program extends throughout the school year and the organization runs fiscally from July 1 – June 30. Program services are designed to put 'reality' into business education. The Youth V.I.B.E. curriculum uses a unique approach to educating youth about business and professional development. Through collaborations with the business community, Youth V.I.B.E. has enhanced its curriculum to include hands-on and interactive components to business mentoring. The curriculum entails business lessons, social discussions, arts, health and computer training. During **Career Tech Week, Youth V.I.B.E. presents to over 120 Participants.** Youth V.I.B.E. also facilitates community outings and tours of local businesses and industries, enabling youth to see first hand how business is accomplished. Before school business training courses teach basic skills from interviewing and dressing for success to advanced course topics such as investment tools and real estate orientation. Youth V.I.B.E. has taught a number of Business Development courses in multiple schools within DeKalb County, currently working with Towers High School, Miller Grove High School, Columbia High School and WD Mohammed High School.

- **Corporate Tours**

Each year Youth V.I.B.E. hosts multiple tours to corporate and small business. This is an effort for students and participants to understand the corporate structure of everyday businesses i.e. movie theaters, restaurants, bowling alleys, museums, banks etc.

- **Youth Empowerment Day – 100 Participants**

Youth V.I.B.E. hosts the annual Youth Empowerment Day Towers High School. This event is geared towards 300-350 students and focuses on exposing youth to multiple industries both traditional and nontraditional.

- **Youth V.I.B.E. Day at the Capitol – 50 Participants**

Youth V.I.B.E. has hosted the annual day at the GA State Capitol. This event serves as a catalyst for economic and political development. On average approximately 50 students from DeKalb County Schools tour the Capitol and meet their elected officials. Lobbyist and business professionals speak on how business and politics works together.

**PROGRAM 2: Food Service Program**

**Youth VIBE Inc. Free and Reduced Lunch Program – 175 Students**

Youth VIBE Inc. serves as the vendor for Mohammed Schools of Atlanta provided free and reduced breakfast, lunch and afterschool snacks for over 175 students. Additionally Youth VIBE provides afterschool concessions for students as well.

**Total Program 2 Expenses: \$93,139**

**PROGRAM 3: Summer Food Service Program**

**Youth VIBE Summer Food Program – 1140 youth served**

Youth V.I.B.E. served 10 afterschool sites during the Summer Food Program. Over 1,140 participants benefited from the program. Youth V.I.B.E. served 3,297 breakfast, 5,501 lunch, 2,745 snacks and 5,304 Dinners totaling 16,847 meals over a 6 week period.

17 Jobs were created (6 Cooks, 4 Monitors, 7 Drivers) 10 school partnerships were created

**PROGRAM 4: Summer Camp**

**Youth V.I.B.E., Inc. Summer Camp- 30 Participants**

Youth V.I.B.E., in partnership with The Georgia Department of Human Resources DeKalb County School System provides a summer arts enrichment program to over 30 students at Towers High School. The mornings cover academic studies including math, English, science, academic enrichment, SAT and GHST preparation along with personal financial management and business planning. The afternoon focuses on music and the arts. Students break into sections and focus on fundamentals to advanced methods and techniques depending upon skill level. Jazz band, solo and ensemble, symphonic band, many various styles of dancing, acting, and theatics are covered.
