	its Family Support Program, for a total of 5,114 participants. Participants took part in a fun and secure environment to develop their
	full potential as productive individuals. Programs supported included Power Hour, Torch Club, Keystone Club, Goals for Graduation,
	Visual Arts, Dance and Theater, and Sports and Recreation. All participants were exposed to educational forums, prevention
	programs agains use and abuse of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs, family support systems, community development programs,
	and sports and recreation programs. For fiscal year 2011-2012, 100% of the work plan presented to PRPHA was accomplished. Major
	program results are as follows: 84% of participants are at grade level for age; 92% of participants are expected to graduate from
	high school and 84% of participants expect to attend college; more than 80% of participants abstained to use alcoholic beverages,
