

**PURPOSES:** The organization is organized exclusively for educational and charitable purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

**SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSES:** To promote and support the production of art and aesthetic inquiry through education, exhibition, and production programs, and to promote aesthetic thought and practice in all aspects of life.

**Part III Description of activities**

Through La Práctica, our fellowship program for emerging artists Beta-Local worked intensively with 8 local and international emerging artists, selected through open call and portfolio review by a jury of 5 international and local artists and curators. Through this program, led by Tony Cruz, Michy Marxuach and Beatriz Santiago Muñoz, artists are challenged to rethink their art practices, generate income from their work, create support structures that promote sustainable experimental work and expand their publics into new communities. Throughout the 2010-11 fellowship year Beta-Local resources committed more than 600 hours of teaching, advising, and production to Fellows and their work, and organized 200 hours of meetings with outside advisors, as well as international visiting artists and other expert advisors in support of the development Fellows' work.

These residents offered more than 17 public talks on their work and research to more than X audience members, met individually and collectively with La Práctica Fellows to advise on their work, led workshops open to the general public and developed art works and/or engaged in research, which was in turn presented publicly in Beta-Local or through collaboration with other art or community organizations such as Colegio de Arquitectos de Puerto Rico. We also collaborated with other non-profit organizations dedicated to supporting artists and their work, such as Creative Capital, and the Pontevedra Biennial in Spain.

Through Lo Pùblico, and including La Ivan Illich Public School Beta-Local organized talks, workshops and other events in topics ranging from bike mechanics to language courses to more specialized art historical and social themes. Through this program we organized more than 13 workshops, of durations ranging from 1 session to 8 sessions on subjects as varied as experimental design, cooking and experimental historiography. 900 participants took part in La Ivan Illich, in over 120 contact hours.

Beta-Local also organized monthly Pin-ups, public presentations and discussions through which artists present a work in progress for critique and dialogue with a wide public.

**Our library and meeting space was used by community members for consultation, research and as a space for discussion and dialogue throughout the year.**
