Although the Foundation is not legally part of the institution and is governed by its own board of directors, the Foundation was incorporated for and exists for the sole purpose of supporting the educational objectives of Henderson State University. Its sole charge is to act on the donor's behalf for the benefit of the university. It guarantees donors, through its directors, that their gifts will be used solely for their intended purpose and ensures that the records will remain as confidential as donors wish. The Foundation is a steward for private resources and uses endowment management and investment strategies to preserve and increase the purchasing power of private funds over time. (Its purpose is to receive, solicit, accept and hold, administer, invest, and disburse property and funds for the educational mission of the University.) The Foundation provides Henderson State University with a "Margin of Excellence" not provided by public funds. Private funding for Henderson through the Henderson State University Foundation is more necessary now than at any time in Henderson's past. Public funding has continued to decline in relation to the total cost for students seeking higher education. Henderson's goal is to keep quality education at affordable prices for citizens of Arkansas and the nation.
